Depends on product type

Master Data

Transactional Data

Parties & Location Information
(GLN, Address, Contact...)

Trade Item Information
(GTIN, name, classification, dimension, weight...)

Shipment Information
(Despatch Advice Number, date of Despatch/Receipt, Ship from/to, transporter identification...)

Logistic Unit Information
(SSCC, content description...)

Batch / Lot or serialised trade item information
(Batch / Lot or serial number, quantity, best before date...)

Public Information

Depends on contractual relationship

Product details as planned, for example:

- Product specifications,
- Process of production,
- Components,
- Origin of raw materials,
- ...

Actual product details, for example:

- Quality records,
- Results of analysis,
- Batch / Lot number of raw materials,
- Identification of interchangeable components that have been used

Private Information

- ✓ **Master Data:** permanent/lasting nature, relatively constant across time, not subject to frequent change, accessed/used by multiple business processes and system applications, neutral/relationship dependent
- ✓ **Transactional Data:** created during the physical flow of goods, can only be collected when events occur.
