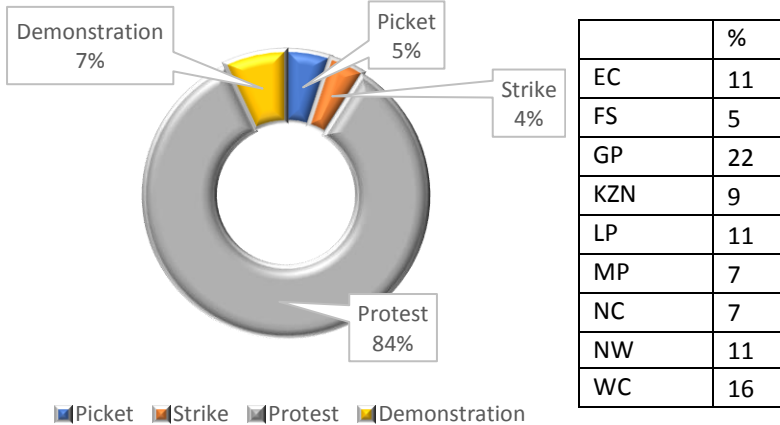

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights the anticipated unrest which has been reported by TopicWorx to the Consumer Goods Council

- Travel disruptions expected near Pilditch Stadium (Pretoria West, Pretoria, Gauteng) on 02/03/2019 owing to annual community safety parade - operational risks foreseen
- Update: Demonstrations anticipated at Polokwane Magistrate Court (Polokwane Central, Limpopo) today (02/04/2019) - travel and security risks anticipated
- Update: Protest action anticipated in Mthatha Central (Eastern Cape) today (02/04/2019) - risks to business operations foreseen
- Notice: Planned water disruptions expected in Johannesburg and Midrand (Gauteng) on 03/04/2019 and 10/04/2019
- NEHAWU picket action anticipated at the USA Consulate (Sandhurst, Sandton, Gauteng) on 04/04/2019 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Municipal by-elections anticipated in Eastern Cape, Northern Cape and Western Cape on 10/04/2019 - unrest probable before, during and after elections
- ANCYL demonstration expected at Thobela FM Head Office (Polokwane, Limpopo) on 03/04/2019 owing to dissatisfaction with alleged unfair dismissals - operational risks foreseen
- Update: Protest action foreseen in Alexandra (Johannesburg, Gauteng) on 03/04/2019 - travel and security risks probable
- Update: Travel and security risks foreseen at Durbn High Court (Durban Central, KwaZulu-Natal) on 11/04/2019 during Siam Lee murder court proceedings - demonstrations probable
- Protest action anticipated on N6 in Kwetyana (Eastern Cape) on 04/04/2019 - risks to travel and security foreseen
- EFF protest march expected in Port Shepstone (KwaZulu-Natal) on 04/04/2019 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Notice: Planned water disruptions expected in Sandton, Lanseria, Roodepoort and Midrand (Gauteng) on 11/04/2019 and 17/04/2019
- Update: Service delivery related protest march anticipated in Tongaat (KwaZulu-Natal) on 06/04/2019 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Update: Demonstrations expected at Johannesburg Magistrate Court (Ferreiras Dorp, Johannesburg, Gauteng) between 09/04/2019 and 11/04/2019 during court proceedings of Mcebo Dlamini - operational risks foreseen
