Approximately one third (1/3) of all food produced globally is lost or wasted, and this is no different in South Africa (FAO, 2011; Oelofse, 2011)

Yet, 13 Million South Africans routinely experience hunger, although access to food is a constitutional right (WWF, 2018)

South African companies are encouraged to commit to this global movement to reduce food waste by half by 2030.
