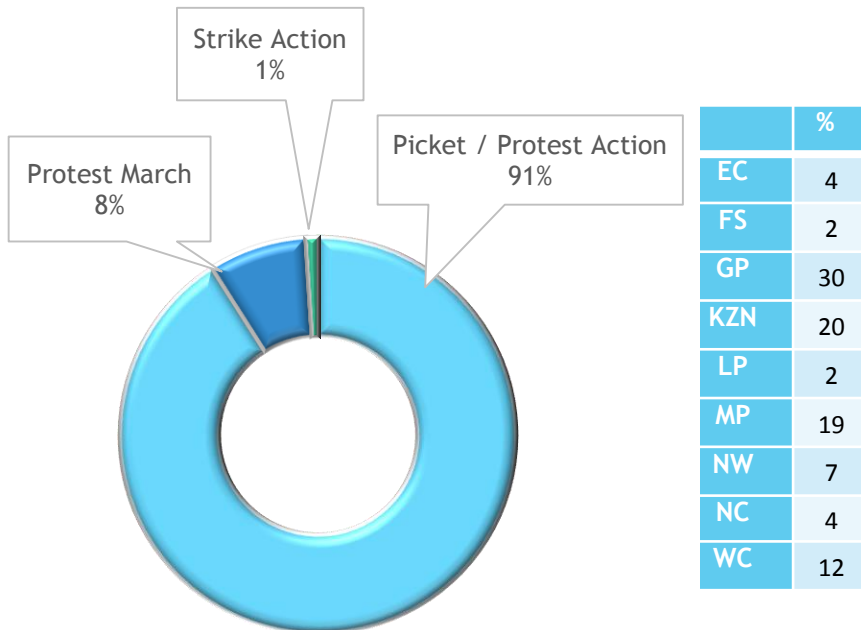

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Protest action expected in several areas in the City of Cape Town Metropolitan Municipality (Western Cape) between 10/07/2019 – 12/07/2019 due to dissatisfaction with high crime levels – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected during Duduzane Zuma’s court proceedings on 12/07/2019 at the Randburg Magistrate Court in Bryanbrink (Randburg, Gauteng) – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at several Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipal Offices in Port Elizabeth (Eastern Cape) during July 2019 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected at Tshwane North TVET College Mamelodi Campus (Phumulamcashi Buffer Zone, Mamelodi, Pretoria, Gauteng) on 15/07/2019 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- EFF sixth anniversary celebrations expected at Kanyamazane Stadium (Kanyamazane-A, Kanyamazane, Mpumalanga) on 27/07/2019 – travel disruptions foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Mankwe Magistrate Court (Mogwase, North West) on 25/07/2019 – operational risks foreseen.
- Ban Animal Trading South Africa picket action anticipated in Hatfield (Pretoria, Gauteng) on 14/07/2019 – risk to travel foreseen.
- ACC picket action anticipated at the High Commission of the Federal Republic of Nigeria in Arcadia (Pretoria, Gauteng) on 15/07/2019 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- ‘Youth United in Prayer’ protest march expected in Mamelodi (Pretoria, Gauteng) on 13/07/2019 – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Emaswazini (near Boston, KwaZulu-Natal) on 12/07/2019 to 13/07/2019 owing to the demand for adequate service delivery – risks to travel and security foreseen on the R617.
- Violence against foreign national truck drivers anticipated nationwide on 18/07/2019 owing to ATDF court proceedings in Pietermaritzburg Central (KwaZulu-Natal) – operational risks expected.
