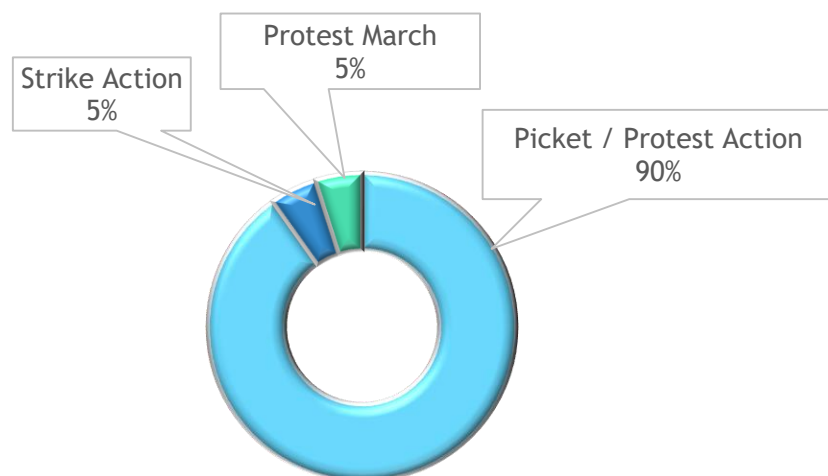

#### TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- SAMWU strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Sol Plaatje Local Municipal Head Office In Civic Centre (Kimberly, Northern Cape) from August 2019 owing to the demand for Section 16 Report – operational risks foreseen.
- Demand for housing expected to result in protest action in several areas in Cape Town Metropolitan Municipality (Western Cape) on 29/09/2019 – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest march to Parliament of South Africa (Cape Town Central, Western Cape) anticipated on 27/08/2019 – business operations likely to be affected.
- GIWUSA and FAWU strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Clover South Africa nationwide from August 2019 owing to possible retrenchments – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Increased likelihood of AMCU strike action and demonstrations in the PGM mining sector from August 2019 owing to ongoing wage negotiations – anticipated demonstrations likely to affect business operations.
- Demonstrations expected at City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipal Head Office (Braamfontein, Johannesburg, Gauteng) on 22/08/2019 – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Protest march by Wits students expected in Johannesburg Central (Gauteng) on 16/08/2019 to demand renaming of Minerals Council South Africa Building – travel and security risks foreseen.
- NUMSA strike action in the Automotive Sector likely from August 2019 following deadlock in wage negotiations – probable demonstrations to result in risks to business operations.
- Protest action expected at UFH Alice Campus (Alice, Eastern Cape) from 19/08/2019 owing to water shortages – travel and security risks anticipated.
- Protest march by SANCO, MTT and MCAC members expected to result in operational risks in Mokopane (Limpopo) on 16/08/2019.
- Demonstrations expected at Sasol Secunda Refineries (near Secunda, Mpumalanga) on 19/08/2019 to demand employment opportunities – travel and security risks foreseen.
