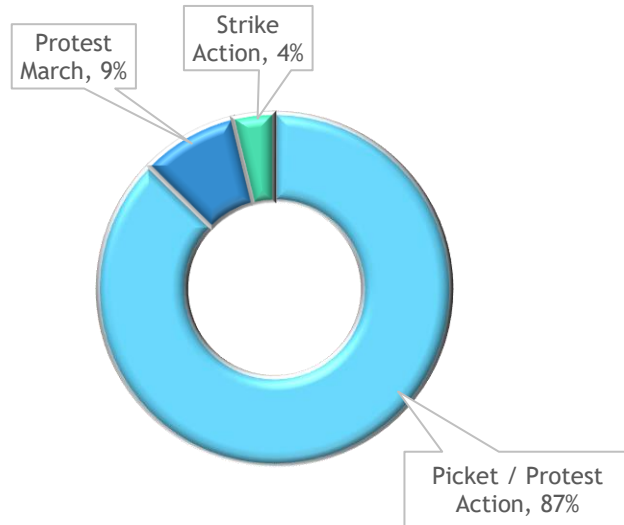

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Security and travel risks foreseen in Tsakane (Mamelodi, Pretoria, Gauteng) from October 2019 due to expected unrest relating to service delivery.
- Housing related grievances anticipated to result in protest action in Wesbank (Malmesbury, Western Cape) from October 2019 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- FAWU demonstrations anticipated at the National DEL in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) from October 2019 owing to possible deregistration of union – risks to business operations foreseen.
- POPCRU 30th anniversary celebrations expected at Curries Fountain Sports Development Centre in Greyville (Berea, Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) 09/11/2019 – travel disruptions likely.
- Probable unrest against foreign nationals on 04/11/2019 anticipated to result in risks to business operations nationwide.
- Demonstrations anticipated by SADTU members at Gauteng DBE Office (Marshalltown, Johannesburg, Gauteng) from October 2019 due to delayed removal of asbestos at school – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Unrest anticipated in Villieria (Pretoria, Gauteng) from October 2019 should additional attempts to illegally occupy land materialise – security and travel risks probable.
- Demonstrations anticipated at the Cape Town Magistrates Court (Cape Town Central, Western Cape) on 29/10/2019 owing to court proceedings regarding assault of minor – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Drought conditions in Baberton and Emjindini (Mpumalanga) anticipated to result in demonstrations from October 2019 – business operations likely to be affected.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Graaff-Reinet (Eastern Cape) from October 2019 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Anticipated liquidation of WCR and closure on Namaqualand operations (near Kleinsee, Western Cape) likely to result in protest action from October 2019 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Service delivery protests anticipated from October 2019 near Tigane (Hartbeesfontein, North West) – travel and security risks expected.
- Demonstrations foreseen in Intsika Yethu Local Municipality (Eastern Cape) from October 2019 owing to drought conditions – operational risks foreseen.
- SATAWU demonstrations expected at PRASA Operations in Gauteng from October 2019 owing to labour related grievances – travel and security risks possible.
- Demonstrations by ANC, EFF and DA members anticipated at the City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipal Head Office (Braamfontein, Johannesburg, Gauteng) from October 2019 – travel and security risks anticipated.
- Unrest foreseen in Westonaria, Waterpan AH and Simunye (Gauteng) from October 2019 owing to dissatisfaction relating to illegally occupied land – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Protest action foreseen in Lenasia (Gauteng) from October 2019 owing to illegal land occupation – security and travel risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated nationwide from October 2019 relating to NHI Bill hearings and implementation – operational risks foreseen.

- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2019/10/18, 18:00. SuperSpar Diederichs, Emalahleni, MP. 3 Suspects. Entered store with firearms and demanded unknown items. Suspects removed unknown items and fled the scene in a white Volkswagen Polo, registration number unknown. Shots fired and injury reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2019/10/24, 19:15. KwikSpar Choose 'n Pay, Germiston, GP. 10-12 Suspects. Entered store with firearms and demanded undisclosed items. Suspects exited the store and fatally wounded a security guard.
