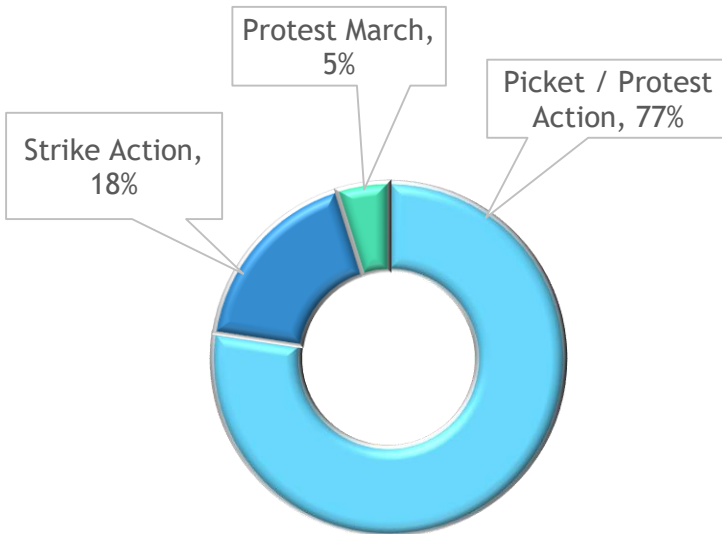

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at SAA operations nationwide from November 2019 owing to dissatisfaction with supposed retrenchments – risks to business operations foreseen.
- NUMSA and SACCA threaten secondary strike action in Aviation Sector from November 2019 owing to labour related grievances – probable risks to business operations foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with inadequate service delivery to result in protest action in several areas in Centurion (Gauteng) from November 2019 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Recent evictions in Kopanong (Mabopane, Pretoria) anticipated to result in unrest in Kopanong during November 2019 and at North Gauteng High Court (Pretoria Central, Gauteng) on 26/11/2019.
- Risk to business operations foreseen at the Pretoria Magistrate Court in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) on 21/11/2019, 27/11/2019 and 04/12/2019 during court proceedings of foreign nationals – demonstrations likely.
- Demonstrations anticipated at Eskom Megawatt Park (Sunninghill, Sandton, Gauteng) from November 2019 owing to dissatisfaction with appointment of CEO – travel and security risks foreseen.
- E-hailing drivers likely to embark on demonstrations in New Brighton (Port Elizabeth, Easter Cape) from November 2019 owing to dissatisfaction with high crime rates – operational risks foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen at Dragon Freight in Bedfordview (Johannesburg, Gauteng) from November 2019 owing to possible SACTWU demonstrations.
- Security guards expected to embark on demonstrations at PRASA operations nationwide from November 2019 to demand reinstatement – operational risks anticipated.
- Demonstrations anticipated in Bo-Kaap (Schotsche Kloof, Cape Town, Western Cape) from November 2019 owing to housing related grievances – business operations foreseen.
- Protest march to demand release of Kanya Cekeshe expected in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) on 29/11/2019 – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Student demonstrations expected at UNISA campuses nationwide from November 2019 owing to dissatisfaction with leaked examination papers – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Demonstrations anticipated at Nelson Mandela Square in Sandown (Sandton, Gauteng) on 29/11/2019 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Illegal land occupation attempts expected along Swartdam Road in Zwelihle (Hermanus, Western Cape) between 22/11/2019 and 24/11/2019 – possible unrest expected to result in operational risks.
- Protest march anticipated in Mokopane (Limpopo) on 26/11/2019 owing to lack of feedback by Mogalakwena Local Municipality on memorandum – risks to business operations foreseen.
- NEHAWU demonstrations expected at Parliament of South Africa (Cape Town Central, Western Cape) on 27/11/2019 – risks to travel and security foreseen.

- CGCRI Burglary, 2019/11/16, 22:17. Pick n Pay Liquor Randstream, Johannesburg, GP. 6 Suspects. Gained access by breaking through front door. Suspects removed liquor and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Attempted Burglary, 2019/11/18, 03:00. Spar Mamelodi, Pretoria, GP. Unknown suspects. Gained access to store via the roof and attempted to gain access to cash office. Reaction vehicle arrived and suspects fled the scene.
