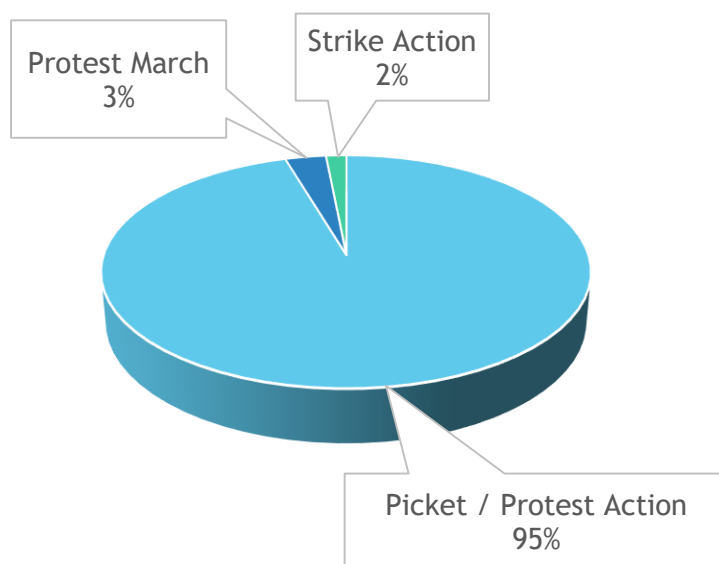

### TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demonstrations anticipated from January 2020 at Hoërskool Delmas (Delmas, Mpumalanga) owing to dissatisfaction with police – travel and security risks expected.
- Demonstrations expected at the Consulate General of India (Stamford Hill, Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) on 24/01/2020 and at Tshisimani Centre for Activists Education (Mowbray, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 26/01/2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Quatro Security Service Head Office in Equestria (Pretoria, Gauteng) from January 2020 owing to labour related grievances – travel and security risks probable.
- Protest action expected in vicinity of RBM (Nzalabantu, near Richards Bay, KwaZulu-Natal) from January 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at Mthwane High School (Kromdraai, near Umzimkulu, KwaZulu-Natal) from January 2020 due to land ownership dispute – travel and security risks foreseen.
- SATAWU strike action underway at several Mpumalanga Governmental Departments (Mpumalanga) owing to the non-payment of salaries – probable demonstrations from January 2020 to result in risks to business operations.
- Municipal by-elections anticipated in Phokwane Local Municipality (Northern Cape) and Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality (Eastern Cape) on 05/02/2020 – unrest probable before, during and after elections.
- Travel and security risks expected at Bloemfontein Magistrates Court (Bloemfontein Central, Free State) during court proceedings on 29/01/2020 owing to anticipated demonstrations.
- Demand for employment likely to result in protest action at several mines near Marikana, Maroelakop, Elandsdrift, Segwaelane and Modderspruit (North West) from January 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at CSIR Sites in several provinces from January 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with retrenchments – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Court proceedings at Mankweng Magistrate Court (Mankweng-C, Mankweng, Limpopo) expected to result in demonstrations on 31/01/2020 – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Anticipated retrenchments at Rustenburg Ferrochrome Smelter (near Karlienpark, Rustenburg, North West) likely to result in protest action from January 2020 – business operations likely to be affected.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Phuthaditjhaba (Free State) from January 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at Cape Town Magistrate Court in Cape Town Central (Western Cape) on 28/01/2020 during court proceedings of foreign nationals – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with police and crime anticipated to result in unrest in Windmill Park (Boksburg, Gauteng) from January 2020 – business operations likely to be affected.
- Travel and security risks expected at Johannesburg Magistrate Court (Ferreiras Dorp, Johannesburg, Gauteng) owing to possible picket action on 29/01/2020 during court proceedings.
- Protest action relating to illegal land occupation expected to materialize in Sydenham (Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from January 2020 – operational risks foreseen.

The below section lists the CGCRI Amavuso Crime Alerts which have been distributed over the course of the past week

- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/01/17, 19:00. Tops Kriel, Kriel, Mpumalanga. 3 Suspects. Entered store with firearms and demanded cash and liquor. Suspects removed cash and stock and fled the scene in a silver Opel Corsa Bakkie, registration number unknown. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/01/18, 20:00. Tops Woodhill, Garsfontein, GP. 2 Suspects. Entered store with pistols and demanded cash and store keys. Suspects removed unknown amount of cash and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/01/22, 12:55. Spar Soshanguve, Soshanguve, GP. 8 Suspects. Entered store and removed cash and cigarettes. Suspects fled the scene in a white unknown van, a white BMW, and a silver Hyundai i20, registration numbers unknown. No shots fired or injuries reported.
