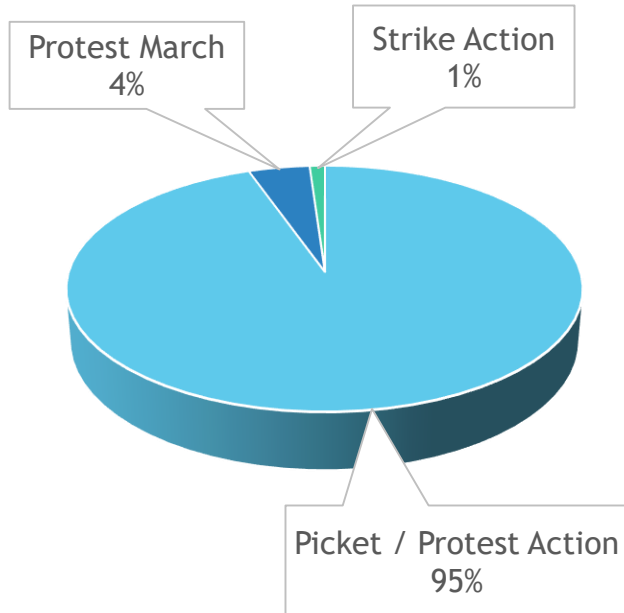

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Risk to travel and security anticipated at the Bellville Magistrate Court in Bellville (Cape Town, Western Cape) on 03/02/2020 during bail application of accused in kidnapping case – demonstrations probable.
- Demonstrations in support of/against Busisiwe Mkhwebane anticipated at the North Gauteng High Court in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) on 04/02/2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Municipal by-elections anticipated in Phokwane Local Municipality (Northern Cape) and Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality (Eastern Cape) on 05/02/2020 – unrest probable before, during and after elections.
- Protest action anticipated in Witpoortjie 117-Ir (Brakpan, Gauteng) during January/February 2020 following illegal land occupation attempts.
- Protest action owing to dissatisfaction with murder of Spar employee anticipated in/near Vrede (Free State) during January/February 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Vanderbijlpark (Gauteng) during January/February 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with inadequate service delivery – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at La Rochelle Primary School (La Rochelle, Rosettenville, Johannesburg South, Gauteng) during January/February 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Gugulethu (Cape Town, Western Cape) during January/February 2020 owing to community dissatisfaction with safety and security – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Biesiesvlei (North West) during January/February 2020 owing to supposed inadequate road safety – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated in Emalahleni (Mpumalanga) during January/February 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with school admissions – travel disruption probable.
- Demonstrations expected in Johannesburg Central (Gauteng) during January/February 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with inadequate water supply – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Service delivery protest action anticipated in/near Rooigrond (North West) during January/February 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action to demand adequate service delivery anticipated in/near Slovo (Kwambonambi, KwaZulu-Natal) during January/February 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected at President High School (Ridgeway, Johannesburg South, Gauteng) during January/February 2020 owing to school grievances – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action to demand construction of shopping centre anticipated in/near The Oaks (Limpopo) during January/February 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demand for employment anticipated to result in protest action at Douglas Colliery (near Komati, Mpumalanga) during January/February 2020 – travel and security likely to be affected.

- CGCRI Attempted Armed Night Robbery, 2020/01/25, 00:12. SuperSpar Bertrams, Johannesburg, GP. 10 Suspects. Arrived at the store with grinding tools and held up a night guard. Another night guard alerted SAPS and the suspects fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/01/29, 18:47. SuperSpar Fontana Berea, Johannesburg, GP. 7 Suspects. Entered store with firearms and held up staff. Removed undisclosed amount of cash. Fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/01/30, 04:31. Tops Gateway, Umhlanga, KwaZulu-Natal. 6 Suspects. Arrived at the store and held up security with a firearm. Suspects removed an unknown amount of liquor and cigarettes. Suspects fled the scene in a red Ford Focus, registration number ND226367. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/01/31, 05:55. Pick n Pay Local Zambezi, Pretoria, GP. Unknown suspects. Entered the store and demanded cash. The suspects removed an unknown amount of cash and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
