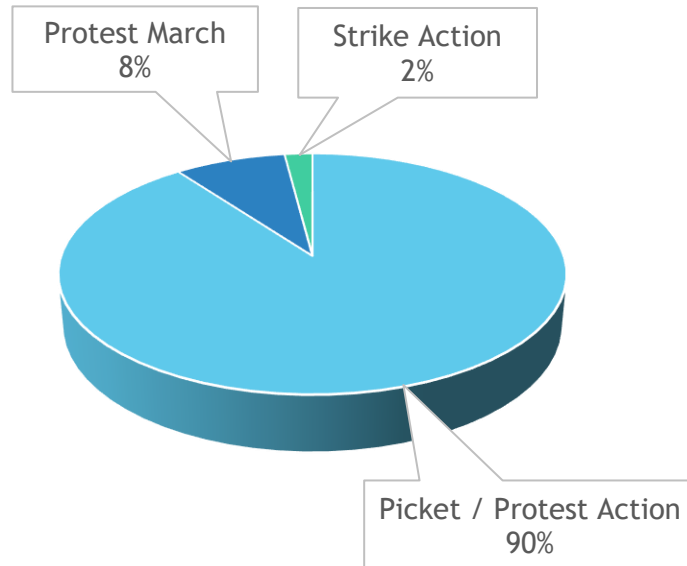

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Strike action at LCM (near Bleskop Mines, North West) likely to result in unrest at the mine during March 2020 – business operations likely to be affected.
- Demonstrations expected at Mitchells Plain Magistrate Court (Mitchells Plain Central, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 17/03/2020 during expected court proceedings – travel and security risks foreseen.
- NUMSA strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at the KZNGBB operations in KwaZulu-Natal from March 2020 following deadlock in wage negotiations – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Malvern (Queensburg, KwaZulu-Natal) from March 2020 due to demand for service delivery and employment – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at SAA Head Office in O.R Tambo (Kempton Park, Gauteng) from March 2020 owing to SAA proceeding with retrenchment processes – risks to business operations foreseen.
- EFF protest march expected to Eskom Free State Provincial Office (Westdene, Bloemfontein, Free State) on 16/03/2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- NMU protest march expected in Johannesburg Central (Gauteng) on 20/03/2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with non-payment of salaries likely to result in strike action and demonstrations in Raslouw AH (Centurion, Gauteng) from March 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- DSW employee strike action underway in eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality (KwaZulu-Natal) owing to grievances with restructuring of overtime pay – probable demonstrations from March 2020 to result in risks to business operations.
- Travel disruptions probable at Dlomo Dam (near Sharpville, Vereeniging, Gauteng) on 21/03/2020 owing to planned EFF rally.
- Demonstrations expected at PRASA Head Office (Hillbrow, Johannesburg, Gauteng) from March 2020 due to labor dispute with subcontractors – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Dissatisfaction with poor school infrastructure likely to result in demonstrations at Mkhuhlu High School (Mkhuhlu, Mkhuhlu, Mpumalanga) from March 2020 – operational risks probable.
- Dissatisfaction with evictions likely to result in protest action at/near Belhar Gardens Rental Estate (Belhar 8, Belhar, Cape Town, Western Cape) from March 2020 – operational risks probable.

Amavuso Crime Alerts

The below section lists the CGCRI Amavuso Crime Alerts which have been distributed over the course of the past week

- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/03/06, 19:00. Tops Lynnwood Lane, Pretoria, GP. 6 Suspects. Entered store with firearms and demanded cash and liquor. Suspects removed unknown amount of cash and liquor. Armed response arrived and the suspects hi-jacked the vehicle and abandoned it near the scene. Suspects fled the scene in a white Ford Kuga and a blue Audi, registrations number unknown. 2 Injuries reported and shots fired.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/03/07, 20:00. Tops Fontana Highpoint, Hillbrow, GP. 5 Suspects. Entered store with firearms and demanded cash and liquor. Suspects removed unknown amount of cash and liquor. Suspects fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Burglary, 2020/03/09, 22:30. 3 African male suspects. Tops Umdloti, Umdloti, KZN. Gained access to the store via the roof. Suspects gained access to the cash management system with the use of a grinder. Suspects removed cash and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
