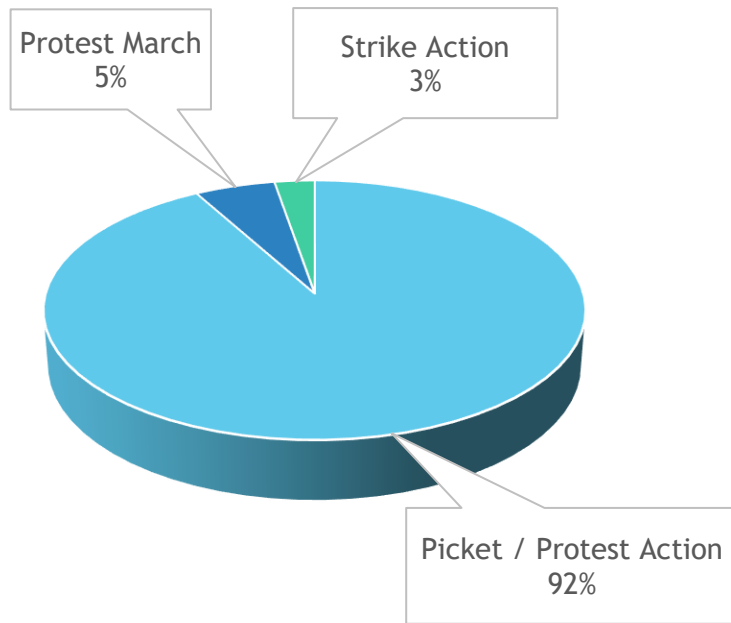

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- EFF protest march expected to Eskom Eastern Cape Provincial Office (Beacon Bay, East London, Western Cape) on 27/03/2020 – travel and security risks anticipated.
- ANC eThekweni Regional Conference anticipated at the ANC eThekweni Regional Office in Durban Central (KwaZulu-Natal) between 03/04/2020 and 05/04/2020 – possible demonstrations to result in travel and security risks.
- Service delivery related demonstrations anticipated at City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipal Head Office (Pretoria Central, Gauteng) from March 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Deadlock in Passenger Bus Sector wage negotiations to result in strike action and/or demonstrations nationwide from April 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen owing to possible public transportation disruptions.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Taste Holdings South Africa Head Office in Frankenwald (Sandton, Gauteng) from March 2020 owing to liquidation of Domino’s Pizza – risk to business operations foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen at Zweledinga informal settlement (T3-V2, Khayelitsha, Cape Town, Western Cape) from March 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with removal of informal structures likely to result in protest action.
- Social disorganization in several areas in Cape Town (Western Cape) expected to result in unrest from March 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- SASCO protest march to Union Buildings (Arcadia, Pretoria, Gauteng) expected to result in risks to business operations on 27/03/2020
- Demonstrations anticipated at the North Gauteng High Court in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) on 24/03/2020 owing to court proceedings relating to City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality – travel and security risks likely.
- NEHAWU demonstrations anticipated nationwide from 30/03/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with possible non-fulfillment of Public Sector wage agreement – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action demanding houses anticipated in Diepkloof (Soweto, Gauteng) from March 2020 – unrest anticipated to result in disruptions to business operations.
- Increased likelihood of unrest in LCM (near Bleskop Mines, North West) from March 2020 during underway strike action – travel and security likely to be affected.
- Dissatisfaction with evictions likely to result in protest action in Sheraton Park (Cape Town, Western Cape) from March 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated along the R544 in Blesboklaagte 296-Js (Emalahleni, Mpumalanga) from March 2020 owing to service delivery grievances – risk to business operations foreseen.
- YNITU strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at several hospitals nationwide from March 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with alleged inadequate equipment and training – operational risks foreseen.

- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/03/13, 15:30. SuperSpar Tasbet, Emalahleni, MP. 3 Suspects. Entered the store, with long guns, and demanded cash from the tills. Suspects removed an unknown amount of cash and fled the scene in a white Volkswagen GTI, registration number unknown. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI CIT - Cross Pavement, 2020/03/14, 09:00. Spar Safi, Thaba Tshwane, GP. Unknown suspects. Approached Fidelity guard and removed cash. Suspects fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
