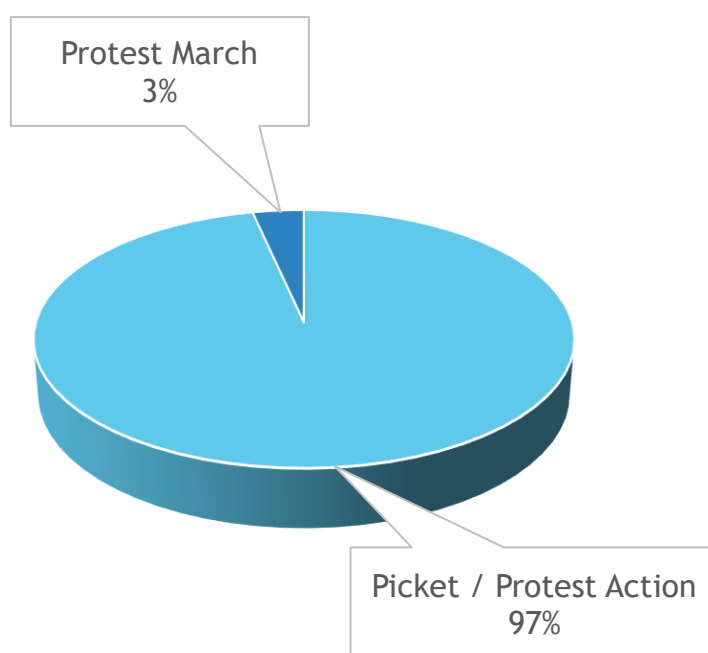

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Housing related protest action likely in Bethelsdorp (Eastern Cape) from March 2020 – risks to business operations likely.
- Protest action anticipated in several communities near Amplants Mogalakwena Platinum Mine (near Ga-Molekana, Mokopane, Limpopo) from March 2020 owing to demand for water – business operations likely to be affected.
- Dissatisfaction with inadequate safety measures at the UFH Alice Campus (Alice, Eastern Cape) to result in protest action from March 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action expected in Motherwell (Eastern Cape) from March 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at the Durban Magistrate Court in Stamford Hill (Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) on 16/04/2020 owing to court proceedings of former Executive Mayor of eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality – operational risks likely.
- Demonstrations anticipated at the Bellville Magistrate Court (Bellville, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 07/04/2020 during court proceedings of kidnapping accused – travel and security risks likely.
- Demand for service delivery likely to result in protest action in Ga-Mampuru (Limpopo) from March 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Mashishing (Lydenburg, Mpumalanga) from March 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Unrest expected in/near Brits (North West) from March 2020 owing to several grievances with Madibeng Local Municipality – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at SA Express Head Office (O.R. Tambo, Kempton Park, Gauteng) from March 2020 owing to non-payment of wages – operational risks foreseen.
- Revised wage increase offer for Public Sector employees - strike action and/or demonstrations resulting in risks to business operations remain likely from March 2020.
- Unrest anticipated in Joe Slovo, KwaDwesi, Westville and Ibhayi (Port Elizabeth, Eastern Cape) from March 2020 – business operations likely to be affected.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Doornkop (Mpumalanga) from March 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen on the N11.
- Unrest anticipated in Klarinet, Coronation and Blesboklaagte 296-Js (Emalahleni, Mpumalanga) from March 2020 due to demand for improved service delivery – risk to travel and security probable.
- Service delivery related protest action expected in/near Dangwana (Eastern Cape) from March 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action expected in Khayelitsha (Cape Town, Western Cape) from March 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Alexandra Magistrate Court (Wynberg, Johannesburg, Gauteng) on 06/04/2020 owing to court proceedings – travel and security at risk.
- Protest action expected in Lotus River (Cape Town, Western Cape) from March 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with alleged sexual assault accused – travel and security at risk.

- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/03/19, 14:40. Tops 1000 Hills, Botha's Hill, KZN. 3-5 African male suspects. Suspects armed with 2 firearms. Suspects removed unknown commodities from store. Suspects fled the scene in a dark blue Volkswagen Polo sedan, registration number unknown. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/03/26, 00:55. Tops Kwamashu, Kwamashu, KZN. 5 Suspects. Gained access to store via the roller shutter door. Suspects held up security with firearms and removed alcohol from store. Suspects fled the scene in a white Toyota Hilux, registration number unknown. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/03/25, 20:50. Spar Ennerdale, Ennerdale, GP. 1 Suspect. Entered store and demanded cash. Suspect removed cash and fled the scene on foot. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Burglary, 2020/03/26, 02:00. Boxer Burgersfort 1, Burgersfort, LP. 3 Suspects. Gained access to store via receiving door. Suspects bombed cash office safe. Suspects were unable to gain access to cash and removed cigarettes. Suspects fled the scene. Shots fired and 1 security guard was shot in the leg.
- CGCRI Burglary, 2020/03/26, 02:30. Rhino Cash & Carry, Umzimkulu, KZN. 1 Suspect. Gained access to the store by breaking through the roof. The suspect removed an unknown amount of cigarettes and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
