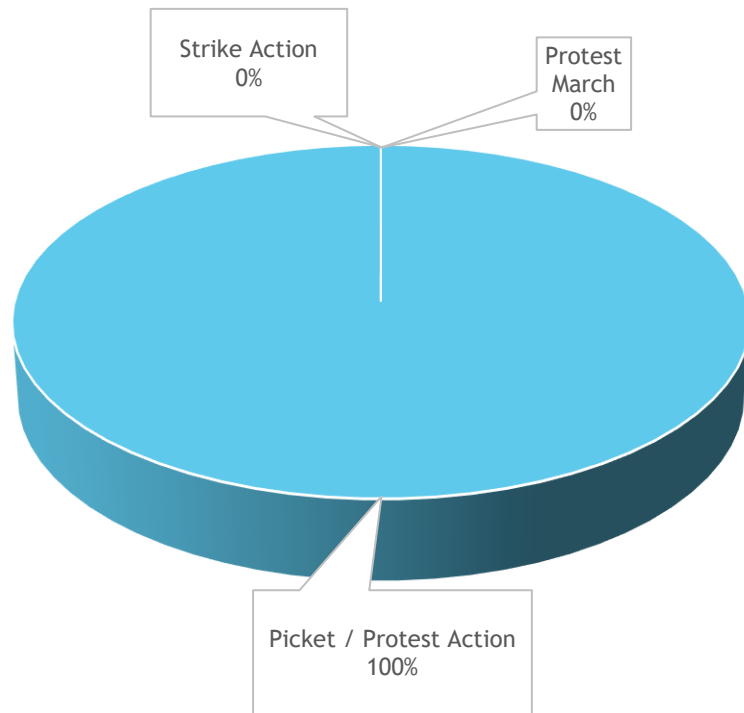

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demonstrations expected nationwide from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with irregularities regarding distribution of food parcels – travel and security risk foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated from April 2020 in/near GG Camp informal settlement (Bongolethu, Oudtshoorn, Western Cape) due to service delivery grievances – business operation risk foreseen.
- SATAWU strike and/or protest action expected at Lonehill Residents Association Studio Office Park (Lonehill, Sandton, Gauteng) from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with living conditions – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at BOC operations (Gauteng) from April 2020 owing to labour related grievances – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Mayfield (Daveyton, Gauteng) from April 2020 owing to vandalism of RDP housing – travel and security risks foreseen.
- NUPSAW strike action and/or demonstrations expected at Far East Rand Hospital (Krugersrus, Springs, Gauteng) from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with alleged violation of lockdown regulations – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected at Qithi and Gwetyibeni (Eastern Cape) from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with violence – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Lancet Laboratories nationwide from April 2020 relating to salary cuts amid the COVID-19 outbreak – operational risks foreseen.
- Labour related demonstrations anticipated from April 2020 owing to possible dissatisfaction with post-lockdown COVID-19 measures at workplace – business operations likely to be affected.
- Anticipated closure of VMR mining operations and resulting retrenchments from April 2020 likely to result in demonstration – risks to business operations probable.
- Demonstrations anticipated at SACP Offices nationwide from April 2020 owing to possible non/late payment of salaries – travel and security risks probable.
- Increased risk for incidents of looting nationwide expected between 24/04/2020 and 28/04/2020 owing to long weekend – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Strike action and/or demonstration anticipated at KAP Holdings nationwide from April 2020 relating to salary cuts amid COVID-19 outbreak – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Ottosdal Magistrate Court (Ottosdal, North West) on 28/04/2020 during court proceedings of suspects looters – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with supposed discrimination expected to result in demonstrations at Embassy of the People’s Republic of China (Arcadia, Pretoria, Gauteng) from April 2020 – travel and security risks likely.
