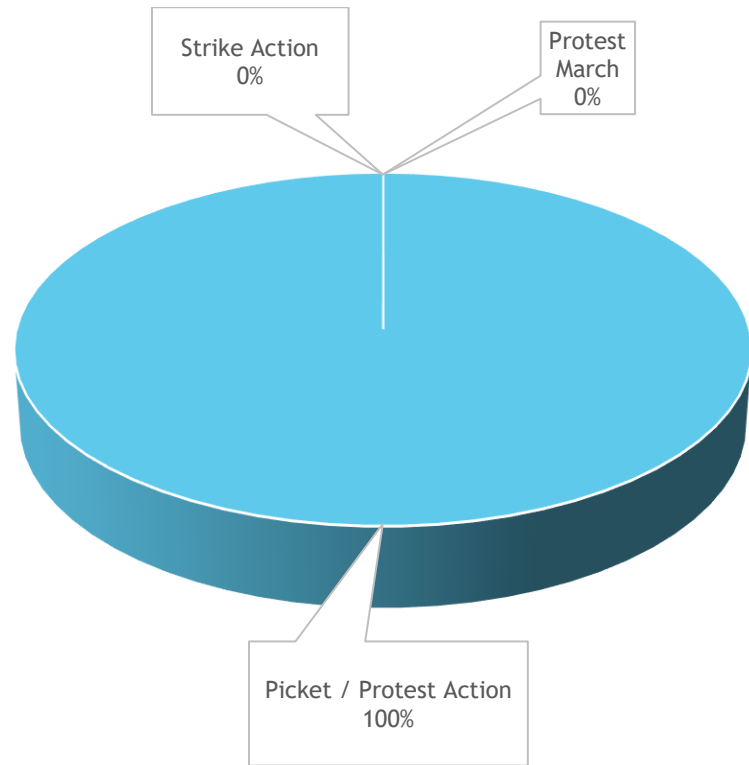




### TopicWorx Alerts – Unrest

### TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at Time Freight depots nationwide from April 2020 owing to possible closure – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated nationwide by Construction Sector employees from April 2020 owing to prolonged delays to business operations – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Demand for food parcels to result in protest action in Plastic View informal settlement (Pretorius Park, Pretoria, Gauteng) from April 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- DENOSA strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at healthcare facilities nationwide from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with recruitment of foreign healthcare professionals – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in eThekweni Metropolitan Municipality (KwaZulu-Natal) from 01/05/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with prolonged lockdown regulations – operational risks foreseen.
- Strike and/or protest action expected as Sasol operations in Gauteng, Mpumalanga, Free State and KwaZulu-Natal from April 2020 due to wage cuts/freezes – operational risk foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at several magistrate courts in Limpopo from April 2020 owing to demand for adequate PPE – operational risks foreseen.
- Increased likelihood on unrest by foreign nationals in informal settlements nationwide from April 2020 – risks to business operations probable.
- Protest action anticipated at Department of Labour offices nationwide from April 2020 due to non-payment from UIF amid COVID-19 outbreak – operational risk foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Ha-Mabila (Limpopo) from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with adequate service delivery – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demand for housing and/or disaster relief likely to result in protest action in Vlakbult (Mpumalanga) from April 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected at L Gromer Poultry Farm (Skeerpoort, Hartbeespoort, North West) from April 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with perceived unfair suspension – operational risks foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in several areas in Mpumalanga, Limpopo and Eastern Cape from April 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.

### Amavuso Crime Alerts

The below section lists the CGCRI Amavuso Crime Alerts which have been distributed over the course of the past week

- CGCRI Burglary, 2020/04/27, 02:00. Tops Botshabelo, Botshabelo, FS. Unknown suspects. Gained access by breaking open the front roller shutter door. Suspects removed an unknown amount of liquor and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/04/28, 17:53. Spar Ennerdale, Ennerdale, GP. 2 Suspects. Entered the store and demanded cash from the tills. Suspects removed an unknown amount of cash and fled the scene. Shots fired and 1 suspect arrested by armed response. No injuries reported.
- CGCRI Attempted Burglary, 2020/04/30, unknown time. Rhino Cash & Carry, Port Shepstone, KZN. 2 Suspects. Gained access to the yard and armed response arrived. 1 Suspect fled the scene and 1 suspect was arrested. No shots fired or injuries reported. No losses reported.
