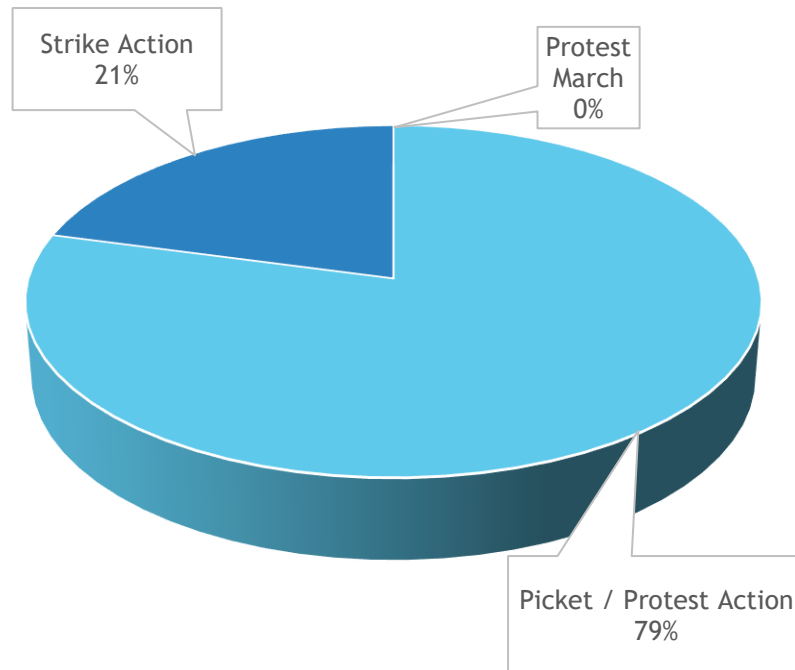

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demonstrations expected at SASSA Offices nationwide from May 2020 owing to grant related grievances – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Unrest anticipated in Vosloorus (Gauteng) from 05/05/2020 due to demand to be addressed by the Minister of Transport – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Eastern Cape from May 2020 amid accusations of tariff increases during lockdown period – disruption to business operations foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at PRASA operations nationwide from May 2020 owing to anticipated retrenchments – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations likely at Koeberg Power Station (Cape Farms, Cape Town, Western Cape) from May 2020 due to positive employee test results from COVID-19 – risks to business operations probable.
- Lindela Repatriation Centre (West Village, Krugersdorp, Gauteng) at risk for unrest from May 2020 due to labour dispute and demand for repatriation – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Bekkersdal (Westonaria, Gauteng) from May 2020 relating to supposed theft of food parcels – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Incidents of stone throwing anticipated along the N2 between Plettenberg Bay and Knysna (Western Cape) during May 2020 – risks to business operations probable.
- Protest action by NUM and AMCU expected at KEM JV Mine (Kimberley, Northern Cape) from May 2020 due to salary cuts amid COVID-19 lockdown – operational risks foreseen.
