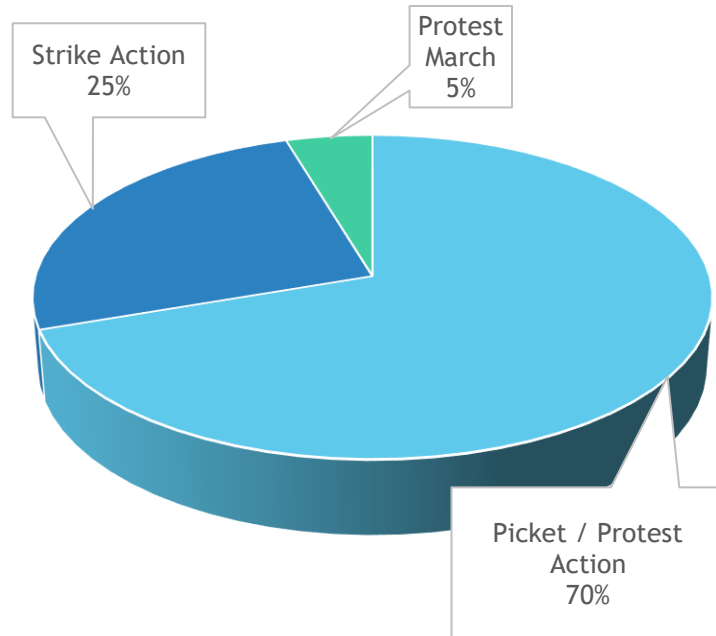

### TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Industrial action expected at Pick n Pay Montana Hypermarket (Montana, Pretoria, Gauteng) from May 2020 owing to positive COVID-19 case – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demand for food parcels to result in protest action in Strand (Western Cape) from May 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Strike action underway at Frere Provincial Hospital in Stoney Drift (East London, Eastern Cape) owing to supposed inadequate preventative measures to curb COVID-19 – probable demonstrations from May 2020 to result in risks to business operations.
- Demonstrations anticipated along the R102 in Cape Town (Western Cape) on 27/05/2020 due to dissatisfaction with lockdown regulations (risks to travel and security foreseen).
- Industrial action expected at Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipal Head Office (East London Central, Eastern Cape) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with temporary closure – operational risks foreseen.
- Industrial action expected at Parkvale Primary School (Valhalla Park, Cape Town) and The Hague Primary School (Delft, The Hague, Cape Town, Western Cape) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with positive COVID-19 cases – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Daveyton (Benoni, Gauteng) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with electricity disruptions – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Parys (Free State) from 27/05/2020 due to electricity disruptions – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Kwadwesi (Ibhayi, Eastern Cape) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with crime – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at the Boxer Meat Factory (Dolphin Coast, KwaZulu-Natal) from May 2020 owing to positive COVID-19 cases – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Mohlakeng (Randfontein, Gauteng) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with electricity disruptions – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- NUMSA to embark on strike action at Macsteel operations nationwide from 28/05/2020 – demonstrations and risks to business operations foreseen.
- Industrial action expected at LFCC (Lorraine, Port Elizabeth, Eastern Cape) from May 2020 owing to positive COVID-19 cases – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Industrial action expected at Evaton Mall (Evaton) and Mandela Square Shopping Centre (Mandela Square, Sebokeng, Vanderbijlpark, Gauteng) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with supposed inadequate working conditions – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Orange Farm (Gauteng) from May 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with lockdown regulations – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated industrial action at King William’s Town Botanical Gardens Refuse Depot (Eastern Cape) from 28/05/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with disruptions in refuse collections.
