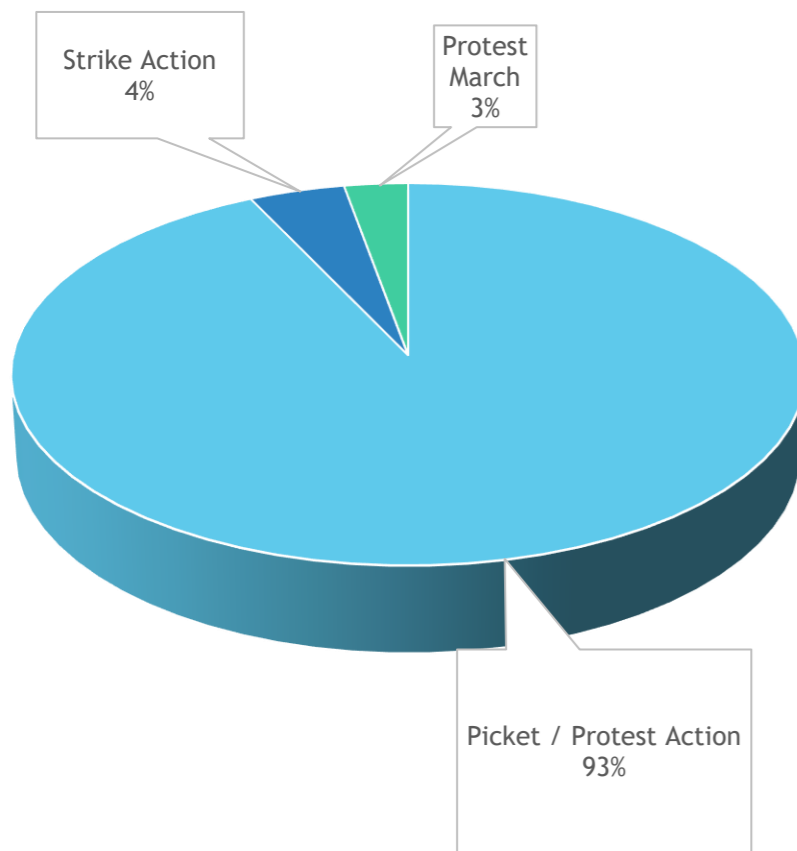

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Zwelindinga informal settlement (near Clarendon Marine, Eastern Cape) from June 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen on Seaview Road.
- Dissatisfaction with non-payment of UIF funds to result in protest action in Hillhead (KwaZulu-Natal) from June 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Eersterust (Pretoria, Gauteng) from June 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with inadequate service delivery – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Power Park and Meadowlands West (Soweto, Gauteng) from June 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with prolonged electricity disruptions – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated in Hout Bay (Cape Town, Western Cape) from June 2020 due to several grievances – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations to voice dissatisfaction with crime expected in Westbury (Johannesburg, Gauteng) from June 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with living conditions at the Potchefstroom Remand Detention Facility in Wilgeboom AH (Potchefstroom, North West) to result in protest action from June 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Moroke and Sekhutlong (Limpopo) from June 2020 owing to demand for water – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Risks to business operations foreseen during anticipated strike action and/or demonstrations at Bheki Mlangeni District Hospital (Jabulani, Soweto, Gauteng) from June 2020 owing to safety related grievances in the psychiatric ward.
- Industrial action expected at several hospitals in Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality (Eastern Cape) from June 2020 owing to several grievances – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Nationwide demonstrations by several taxi associations expected from 29/06/2020 opposing lockdown regulations – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in the vicinity of Bakubung Platinum Mine (near Ledig, North West) from June 2020 owing to demand for employment – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Nkwaleni (KwaZulu-Natal) from June 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen on the R66.
- Protest action anticipated near Dundee (KwaZulu-Natal) from June 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with reopening of schools – travel and security risks foreseen on the R33.
- DEMAWUSA demonstrations anticipated at the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipal Head Office in Port Elizabeth Central (Eastern Cape) from June 2020 owing to the demand for insourcing – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at the South Gauteng High Court in Johannesburg Central (Gauteng) on 06/07/2020 during court proceedings relating to sentencing of sexual assault accused – risks to travel and security likely.
- Demand for employment at mines expected to result in unrest in several areas in Northern Cape from June 2020 – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Protest and/or picket action expected at Enterprise Ilembe Economic Development Agency Head Office (Dolphin Coast, KwaZulu-Natal) from June 2020 – travel and security risks anticipated.
- Closure of PetroSA's Mossgas Project near Mossel Bay (Western Cape) to result in industrial action from July 2020 due to probable retrenchments – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Chesterville (Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from June 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with crime in the area – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Dissatisfaction with prolonged electricity disruptions expected to result in protest action in Baviaanspoort (Roodeplaat, Gauteng) from June 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Bultfontein (Mpumalanga) from June 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with reopening of schools – travel and security risks foreseen.
- EFF demonstrations expected at East London Magistrate Court (East London Central, Eastern Cape) on 16/07/2020 due to court proceedings of Julius Malema – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Truck strike action and demonstrations anticipated from 07/07/2020 in several provinces – travel and security likely to be affected on several main roads.
- Annual adjustment of health sector likely to result in demonstrations at Gauteng DoH Head Office (Johannesburg Central, Gauteng) from July 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- COSAS protest march to the North West DoE Head Office in Mmabatho (Mahikeng, North West) anticipated on 10/07/2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Exclusion from community projects anticipated to result in social disorganisation in several areas in Rustenburg Local Municipality (North West) from July 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at Western Cape schools from July 2020 due to COVID-19 infections – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Alexandra (Johannesburg, Gauteng) from 01/07/2020 due to electricity disruptions – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Nationwide demonstrations against the ban on the sale of tobacco products anticipated on 08/07/2020 – risks to travel and security probable.
- Protest action anticipated in Duncan Village (East London, Eastern Cape) from July 2020 due to dissatisfaction with allocation of labour contracts – travel and security risks foreseen.
- EFFSC demonstrations expected at DHET offices and higher education institutions nationwide from July 2020 owing to several demands – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Picket action by teachers expected on corner of Morgenster Road and Merrydale Avenue in Lentegeur (Mitchells Plain, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 03/07/2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Wits Health Science Campus in Parktown (Johannesburg, Gauteng) from July 2020 due to COVID-19 vaccination trial in Africa – travel and security risks anticipated.
