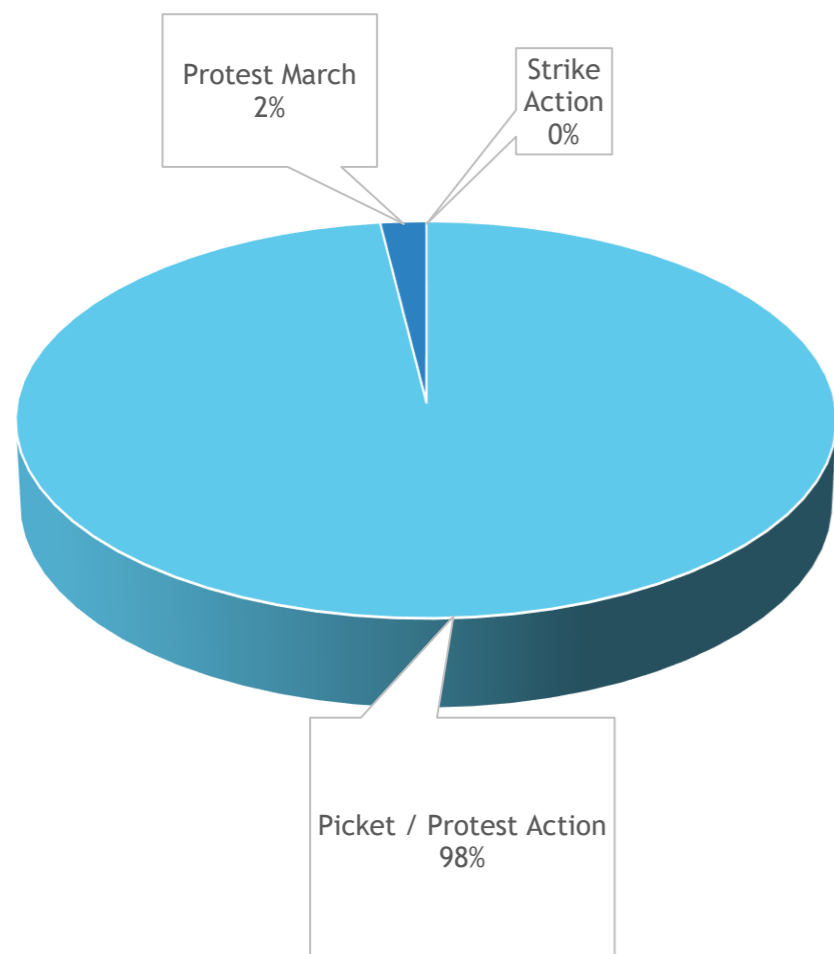

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Dissatisfaction with electricity disruptions expected to result in protest action in Groutville (KwaDukuza, KwaZulu-Natal) from July 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Marievale (Nigel, Gauteng) from July 2020 owing to the dissatisfaction with possible eviction attempts – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in several areas in Pietermaritzburg (KwaZulu-Natal) from July 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated in Stellenbosch Central (Western Cape) from July 2020 owing to the demand for salary increases – operational risks foreseen.
- Attempts to illegally occupy land expected to result in unrest along the N4 near Brits (North West) from July 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality agrees to SAMWU wage increase demands – strike action and/or demonstrations by SAMWU remain probable in Pretoria Central and Bronkhorstspuit (Gauteng) from 29/07/2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Zwide (Ibhayi, Eastern Cape) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with crime – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demand for housing expected to result in protest action in Nomzamo (Strand, Western Cape) from July 2020 – risks to travel and security applicable.
- Community grievances in Newcastle, Madadeni and Osizweni (Newcastle, KwaZulu-Natal) anticipated to result in unrest from July 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Risks to travel and security foreseen during anticipated demonstrations in Observatory (Cape Town, Western Cape) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with recent evictions.
- Community protest action anticipated in/near Klipriviersoog (Soweto, Gauteng) from July 2020 – travel and security risks expected.
- Demonstrations by Gatvol Capetonian movement supporters expected in several areas in Cape Town (Western Cape) from July 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with alleged physical assault incident expected to result in demonstrations at uBulinga High School (Moyeni, KwaZulu-Natal) from July 2020 – travel and security risks anticipated.
- SAMWU members anticipated to embark on industrial action in City of Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality (Gauteng) from July 2020 relating to labour grievances – operational risks foreseen.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Rheenendal (Western Cape) from July 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Northdale Hospital (northdale, Pietermaritzburg, KwaZulu-Natal) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with inadequate working conditions – travel and security risks foreseen.
- NUMSA industrial action anticipated at the Nation DEL in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with the non-payment of salaries/TERS payments – operations risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations by EE and pupils anticipated at several school in Eastern Cape from August 2020 owing to inadequate conditions/infrastructure at schools – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Industrial action expected at Bolt Head Office (Kramerville, Sandton, Gauteng) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with introduction of Bolt Go – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated protest action in Dunoon (Cape Town, Western Cape) from July 2020 owing to demand for adequate sanitation facilities.
- Demonstrations relating to illegally occupies land anticipated in Makhaza (Khayelitsha, Cape Town, Western Cape) from July 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Risks to travel and security foreseen during anticipated protest action in Cove Ridge East (East London, Eastern Cape) from July 2020 owing to the dissatisfaction with recent evictions.
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Petrusville (Northern Cape) from July 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in/near Khenana informal settlement (Berea, Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with removal of informal structures – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Risks to travel and security foreseen during anticipated protest action in Bongoletu (Oudtshoorn, Western Cape) from July 2020 due to the demand for water and sanitation.
- Allegations of racism likely to result in demonstrations at Merchiston Preparatory School (Pietermaritzburg Central, KwaZulu-Natal) from July 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in/near Lenasia Extension 13 (Lenasia, Gauteng) from July 2020 due to illegal land occupation – business operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Paardekop Vrugte (Citrusdal, Western Cape) from July 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with evictions – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Travel and security risks anticipated at Nkowankowa Magistrate Court (Nkowankowa, Limpopo) on 31/07/2020 during court proceedings.
- Protest action expected in Makause informal settlement (Primrose, Germiston, Gauteng) from July 2020 following removal of illegal electricity connections – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with perceived inadequate service delivery expected to result in protest action in Rethabiseng (Bronkhorstspuit) and Soshanguve (Gauteng) from July 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Motorcade demonstrations anticipated between Athlone (Cape Town) and Cape Town Central (Western Cape) on 31/07/2020 – travel disruptions foreseen.
