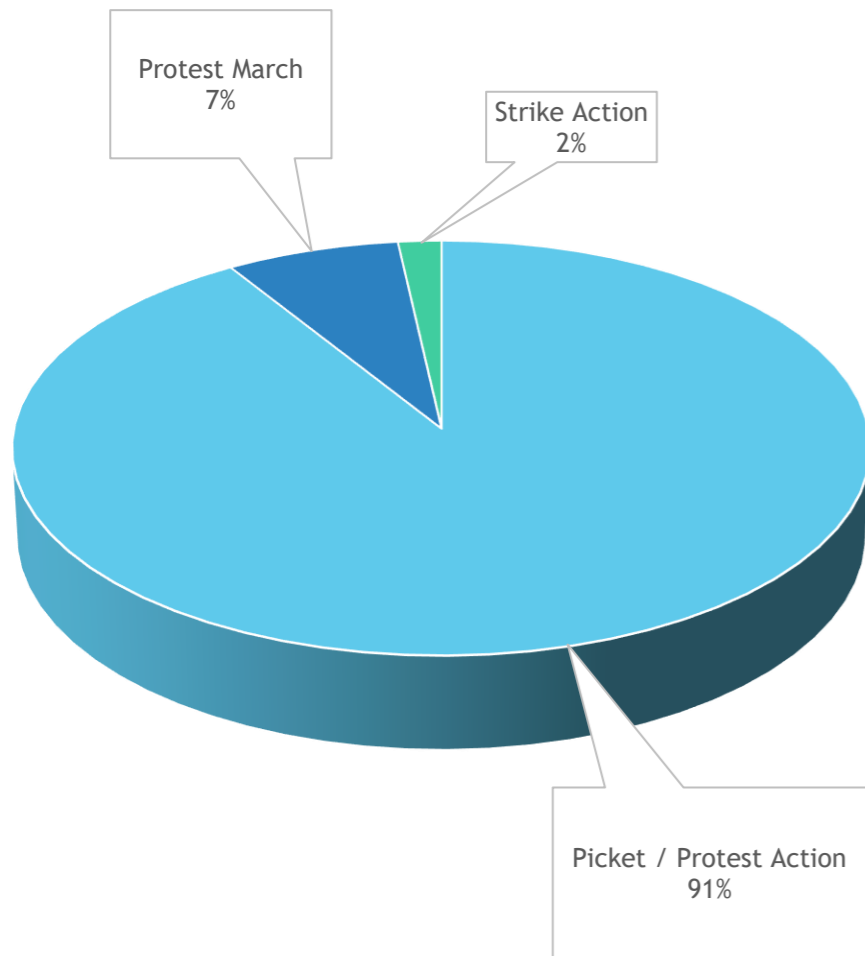

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Unrest anticipated in several areas in John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality (Northern Cape) from 17/08/2020 owing to grievances with mines – operational risks foreseen.
- Unrest expected at Limpopo College of Nursing in Giyani (Giyani-D, Giyani, Limpopo) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with perceived inadequate safety measures at student residence.
- ATDF related demonstrations anticipated nationwide from 23/08/2020 until 28/08/2020 due to dissatisfaction with foreign national truck drivers – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action against removals of illegal electricity connections anticipated in Thembaletu (George, Western Cape) from 17/08/2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Risks to travel and security foreseen in Alexandra (Johannesburg, Gauteng) from 18/08/2020 owing to electricity disruptions.
- NEHAWU strike action anticipated at NHLS operations nationwide from August 2020 owing to unaddressed labour grievances – demonstrations resulting in risks to business operations foreseen.
- Unrest anticipated at ANC Head Office in Johannesburg Central (Gauteng) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with police response to protest march – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at mining operations in Marikana (Marikana, North West) from August 2020 owing to demand for compensation – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at NSFAS Head Office (Wynberg, Cape Town, Western Cape) from August 2020 following retraction of funding for 5 000 students – travel and security risks anticipated.
- Industrial action expected at Tshwane District (Prinshof 349-Jr, Pretoria) and Dr George Mukhari Academic (Ga-Rankuwa Unit 2, Ga-Rankuwa, Gauteng) Hospitals from August 2020 owing to unfair working conditions – operational risks foreseen.
- Water disruptions in Ladysmith (KwaZulu-Natal) to result in protest action from August 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- NSFAS related protest action expected at TUT Soshanguve South (Soshanguve L, Soshanguve) and Soshanguve North (Soshanguve M, Soshanguve, Gauteng) from August 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Tshilwavirusiku (Ha-Ravele), Elim Hospital (Waterval-A, Louis Trichardt) and Nzhelele Post Offices (Nzhelele, Limpopo) from August 2020 owing to demand for COVID-19 relief funds – operational risks foreseen.
- Housing related protest action anticipated in Burgersfort Extension 10 (Burgersfort) and Talana (Arbor Park, Tzaneen, Limpopo) from August 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Nationwide strike action and demonstrations by NEHAWU anticipated from 21/08/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with lack of PPE and staff shortages at hospitals – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Extinction Rebellion demonstrations against offshore drilling project expected at Total Head Office (Rosebank, Sandton, Gauteng) from August 2020 – travel disruptions anticipated.
- Dissatisfaction with possible water restrictions expected to result in unrest in City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality (Gauteng) from August 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Illegal land occupation related protest action expected in several areas in Gauteng from August 2020 – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Demonstrations owing to dissatisfaction with farm murders anticipated in Pretoria and Centurion (Gauteng) on 29/08/2020 – travel disruptions foreseen.
- NEHAWU strike action and/or demonstrations expected in the Public Sector from 03/09/2020 owing to non-fulfilment of wage agreement – risks to business operations foreseen.
- EFF protest action anticipated at Hillbrow Magistrate Court (Braampark, Johannesburg, Gauteng) and at PRASA Operations nationwide from 21/08/2020 due to labour grievances – business operational risks foreseen.
