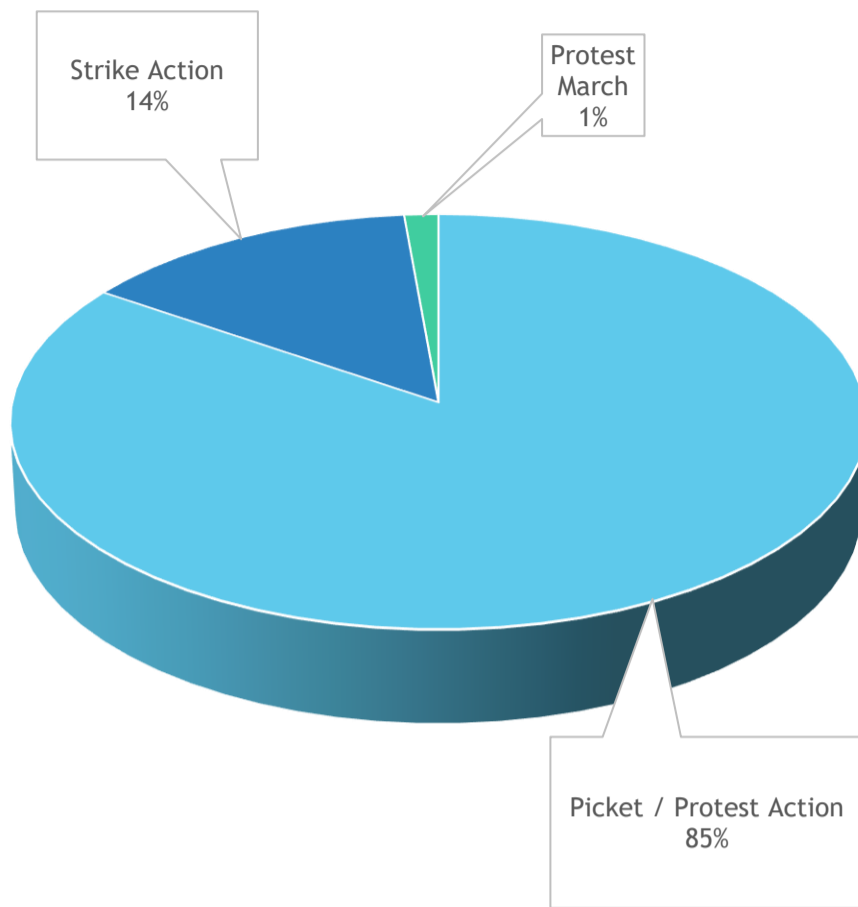

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated in Matzikama Local Municipality (Western Cape) from August 2020 owing to supposed financial difficulties – operational risks foreseen.
- Industrial action anticipated at several tourist attractions and hospitality sites in Cape Town (Western Cape) from August 2020 owing to possible retrenchments resulting from COVID-19 nationwide lockdown – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demand for adequate service delivery likely to result in protest action in Mgome (KwaZulu-Natal) from August 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- SAMWU demonstrations anticipated at National Department of Human Settlements, Water and Sanitation (Pretoria Central, Gauteng) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with involvement in negotiation processes – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at ECD centres nationwide from August 2020 owing to demand for COVID-19 relief funds – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations to voice dissatisfaction with GBV anticipated in Western Cape, Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal on 29/08/2020 – travel disruptions foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated protest action in Ermelo (Mpumalanga) from August 2020 owing to demand for adequate service delivery.
- Unrest foreseen in Jeffreys Bay (Eastern Cape) from August 2020 owing to route dispute between rival taxi associations – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Protest action anticipated in Kuyasa (Khayelitsha, Cape Town, Western Cape) from August 2020 due to illegal land occupation grievances – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with removal of informal structures likely to result in protest action in Elsies Rivier (Cape Town, Western Cape) from August 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demand for improved infrastructure likely to result in demonstration at Inkqubela Primary School (Kwazakele, Kwazakele, Ibhayi, Eastern Cape) from August 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with removal of informal structures expected to result in protest action in Reservoir Hills (Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from August 2020 – operational risks anticipated.
- SADTU demonstrations expected at schools and DBE offices nationwide from August 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstration anticipated in Mamelodi and Nellmapius (Pretoria, Gauteng) from August 2020 due to demand for housing – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at SAA Head Office in O.R Tambo (Kempton Park, Gauteng) from August 2020 amid ongoing retrenchments – operational risks foreseen.
- MKMVA demonstrations expected at the Union Buildings (Arcadia, Pretoria, Gauteng) from August 2020 due to dissatisfaction with perceived unfair treatment – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Operational risks foreseen during anticipated demonstrations at George Magistrate Court (George Central, Western Cape) on 28/08/2020 owing to court proceedings of murder accused.
- Protest action expected in Witsand (Atlantis, Western Cape) from August 2020 due to route dispute between taxi and bus drivers – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at UniVen Thohoyandou Campus (Thohoyandou, Limpopo) from August 2020 following sexual assault of students – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Demand for electricity likely to result in protest action in Pimville (Soweto, Gauteng) from August 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Possible retrenchments to result in strike action and/or demonstrations at Imperial Logistics Head Office in Bedfordview (Germiston, Gauteng) from August 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Taxi related unrest anticipated in/near Emalahleni (Mpumalanga) from August 2020 – risks to business operations probable.
- Demonstrations expected at GDE Ekurhuleni North District Office (Benoni Central, Gauteng) from August 2020 owing to demand for scholar transportation – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action foreseen at UniZulu Main Campus (KwaDlangezwa, KwaZulu-Natal) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with crime – risks to security and travel anticipated.
- Unrest anticipated in Lekwa (Mpumalanga) and Ngwathe (Free State) Local Municipalities from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with lack of changed to NMD – operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action expected in Namakgale (Phalaborwa, Limpopo) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with inadequate RDP houses – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Mamelodi Magistrate Court (Naledi, Pretoria, Gauteng) on 03/09/2020 during court proceedings of sexual assault accused – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Risks to travel and security foreseen during anticipated demonstrations at Soshanguve Magistrate Court (Soshanguve-F, Soshanguve, Gauteng) on 04/09/2020 during court proceedings of sexual assault accused.
- Demand for water expected to result in protest action in Ulundi (KwaZulu-Natal) from August 2020 – travel disruptions and security risks foreseen.
- Demand for employment likely to result in protest action at VMR West Gold Plant (Orkney, North West) from August 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at Mfuleni Community Dar Centre (Mfuleni) and Gugulethu Community Health Centre (Gugulethu, Cape Town, Western Cape) from August 2020 owing to several grievances – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Non-payment of employee salaries to result in SAMWU industrial action at City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipal Head Office in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) from August 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at STA Travel South Africa Operations nationwide from August 2020 following the permanent suspension of operations – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Stutterheim (Eastern Cape) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with the reinstatement of Nokuzola Mlahleki – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Unrest expected in Bophelong (Vanderbijlpark, Gauteng) from August 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with foreign national businesses – operational risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with removal of informal structures likely to result in protest action in Mfuleni (Cape Town, Western Cape) from August 2020 – travel disruptions and security risks anticipated.
- Protest marches by SAUV anticipated in several provinces on 29/08/2020 owing to several grievances – risks to travel disruptions foreseen.
