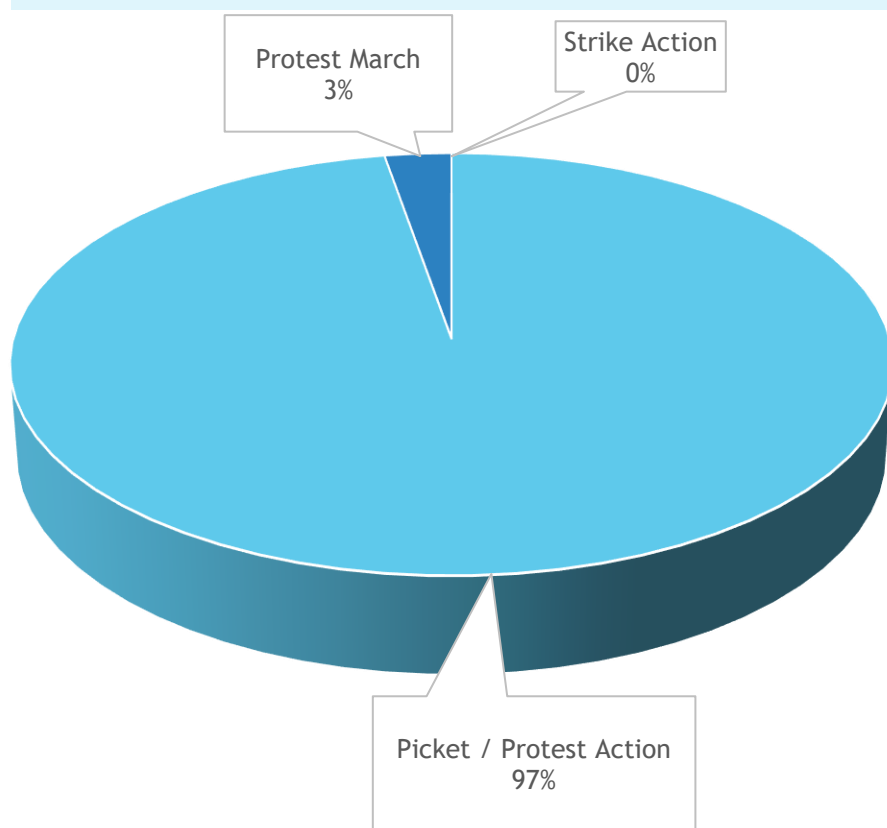

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demand for rail infrastructure expected to result in demonstrations in several areas in Gauteng, Mpumalanga and Limpopo from September 2020 – risks to business operations anticipated.
- Court proceedings of Thandeka Mdeliswa murder accused to result in demonstrations at the Evander Magistrate Court (Evander, Mpumalanga) on 21/09/2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Travel disruptions foreseen at the Ventersdorp Magistrate Court (Ventersdorp, North West) on 21/09/2020 owing to probable demonstrations during court proceedings of farm attackers.
- NEHAWU threatens lunchtime picket actions nationwide from September 2020 following non-response from South African Government to list of demands on 10/09/2020 – additional strike action and/or demonstrations to result in operational risks.
- Demonstrations anticipated in several provinces on 19/09/2020 relating to dissatisfaction with farm murders – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest march against foreign nationals to High Commission of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (Arcadia, Pretoria, Gauteng) expected to result in travel and security risks on 23/09/2020.
- EFF protest action foreseen on the N14 near Kathu (Northern Cape) from September 2020 due to dissatisfaction with delayed road upgrades – travel and security risks foreseen.
- SACC picket action anticipated at the Offices of the Premiers nationwide during September 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with supposed corruption in the South African Government – travel disruptions and security risks foreseen.
- Travel disruptions and security risks anticipated during expected taxi-related unrest in Unclear (Bellville, Cape Town, Western Cape) from September 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with unresolved route disputes.
- Court proceedings of Nathaniel Julius murder accused to result in demonstrations at the Protea Magistrate Court (Protea North, Soweto, Gauteng) on 22/09/2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Service delivery protest action anticipated in several areas in Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality (Eastern Cape) from September 2020 regarding water tariff disputes – operational risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with inadequate service delivery to result in protest action in Empolweni and Ethembeni informal settlements in Harare (Khayelitsha, Cape Town, Western Cape) from September 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations to demand employment opportunities for locals expected at Motherwell Centre (Motherwell 4, Motherwell, Eastern Cape) on 21/09/2020 – risks to business operations anticipated.
- ACM/OMC demonstrations against corruption anticipated in Van Riebeeckpark (Bluff), Sherwood Park (Durban) and Durban North (KwaZulu-Natal) on 18/09/2020 – travel disruptions foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected during court proceedings at Polokwane Magistrate Court (Polokwane Central, Limpopo) on 25/09/2020 – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- EFFSC demonstrations expected at UCT Main Campus (Rondebosch, Cape Town, Western Cape) from 21/09/2020 owing to demand for reopening of residences and facilities – risks to business operations foreseen.

- CGCRI Attempted Armed Robbery, 2020/09/11, 19:45. SuperSpar Fontana Highpoint, Hillbrow, GP. Unknown suspects. Entered the store and attempted a robbery. Armed response arrived and a shootout occurred. Suspects fled the scene. No injuries reported.
- CGCRI Burglary, 2020/09/13, 03:00. SPAR Soutpansberg, Louis Trichardt, LP. Unknown suspects. Gained access through the roof and used a grinder to open the G4S safe. Suspects removed cash and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI CIT - Cross Pavement, 2020/09/14, 13:15. Shoprite Mhluzi, Middelburg, MP. 4 Suspects. Approached the CIT guard and removed cash. Suspects fled the scene in a white Nissan Sentra, registration number unknown. Further details unknown.
- CGCRI Burglary, 2020/09/15, 23:00. Woolworths The Glen Oakdene, Oakdene, Johannesburg, GP. Unknown suspects. Gained access through a window. Suspects removed clothing and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
