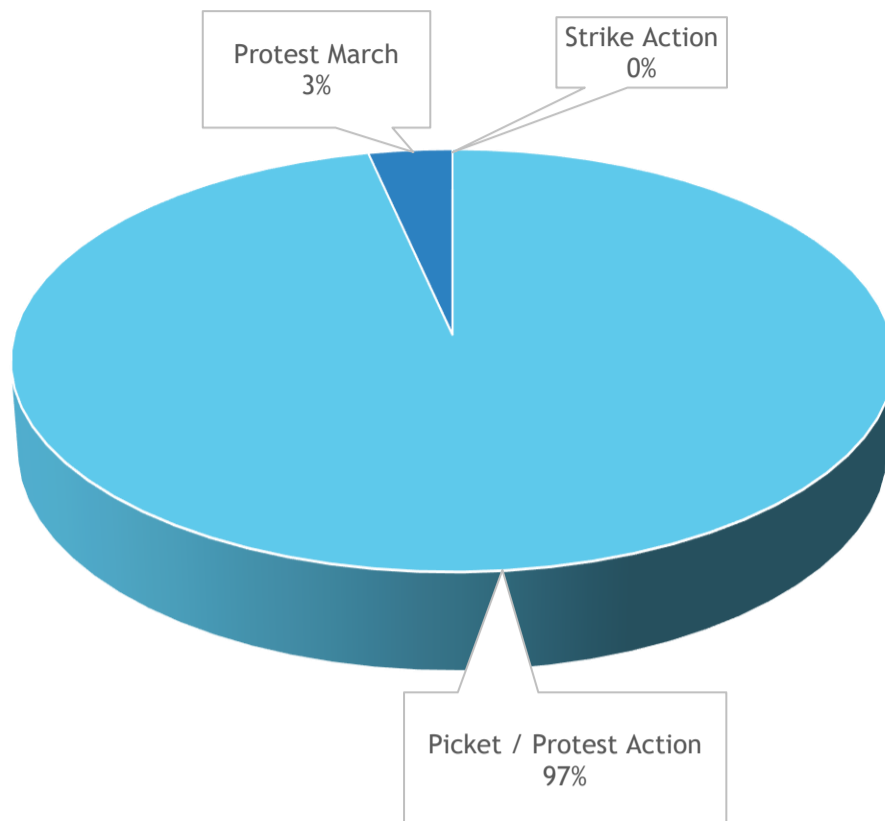

The below section lists the CGCRI Amavuso Crime Alerts which have been distributed over the course of the past week

- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/09/25, 20:30. Pick n Pay Sable Square, Cape Town, WC. 4 Suspects. Entered the store and demanded cash from the tills. Suspects removed cash and fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/09/26, 01:30. Boxer Centani, Kentani, EC. 4 Suspects. Triggered the alarm and awaited the store manager. Suspects demanded cash from the cash office and cigarettes. Suspects removed cash, cigarettes, and a cellphone and fled the scene in the manager's vehicle. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/09/27, 18:23. SPAR Linton Grange, Port Elizabeth. EC. 3 Suspects. Entered the store and demanded cash from the tills and cigarettes. Suspects removed cash and cigarettes and fled the scene in an unknown Nissan Micra. No shots fired or injuries reported.
- CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/09/28, 02:30. SPAR and TOPS Northwold, Randburg, GP. 6 Suspects. Held up the security and removed his uniform. Suspects gained access to the stores and used a grinder to open 2 safes. Suspects removed cash, cigarettes and other stock. Guard was able to make alarm and the suspects fled the scene. No shots fired or injuries reported.

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demonstrations expected at Eskom offices and/or power stations nationwide from 29/09/2020 owing to several grievances – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Hangberg informal settlement (Hout Bay Heights, Hout Bay Harbour, Hout Bay, Cape Town, Western Cape) from September 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with evictions – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Protest action in demand of land and housing anticipated in Laingville (St Helena Bay, Western Cape) from September 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Risks to business operations foreseen in Pomeroy (KwaZulu-Natal) from September 2020 owing to anticipated service delivery related protest action.
- PSA industrial action anticipated at SARS operations nationwide from October 2020 owing to salary dispute – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at Mango Airlines Head Office in O.R. Tambo (Kempton Park, Gauteng) from September 2020 owing to non-payment of technical/maintenance service fees – risks to business operations foreseen.
- MKMVA demonstrations anticipated in Durban Central (KwaZulu-Natal) from 28/09/2020 pending outcome in negotiations with ANC regarding several grievances – risks to business operations probable.
- Court proceedings of murder accused likely to result in demonstrations at the Bishop Lavis Magistrate Court (Bishop Lavis, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 05/10/2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen in Bayland informal settlement (Kwadwesi, Ibhayi, Eastern Cape) from September 2020 due to anticipated housing protest action.
- Unrest anticipated in Langa (Cape Town, Western Cape) from 20/10/2020 pending evictions – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Taxi route dispute expected to result in unrest in Flanders (KwaZulu-Natal) from September 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at Frere Provincial Hospital in Stoney Drift (East London, Eastern Cape) from September 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with supposed inadequate conditions and mistreatment – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Risks to travel and security expected during anticipated unrest in Alexandra (Johannesburg, Gauteng) from September 2020 following fire.
- Court proceedings of sexual assault accused anticipated to result in demonstration at Mitchells Plain Magistrate Court (Mitchells Plain Central, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 08/10/2020 – operational risks expected.
- Travel risks foreseen between George and Knysna (Western Cape) on 03/10/2020 during anticipated protest march against farm murders.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at Caltex Chevron Cape Town Refinery (Cape Town, Western Cape) from September 2020 owing to labour related grievances – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demand for water and electricity likely to result in protest action in Misty Mount (Eastern Cape) from September 2020 – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected at UNISA campuses nationwide from September 2020 owing to several grievances – operational risks foreseen.
- Bolt e-hailing driver strike action and demonstrations expected at Bolt Head Office (Kramerville, Sandton, Gauteng) from September 2020 owing to labour grievances - travel and security risks anticipated.
- Protest action relating to illegal land occupation foreseen in Lawley, Ennerdale and Lenasia South (Gauteng) from September 2020 – risks to travel and security probable.
- Court proceedings of murder accused expected to result in demonstrations at Wynberg Magistrate Court (Wynberg, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 06/10/2020 – risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Operational risks foreseen during anticipated #PutSouthAfricansFirst protest march to the DHA Head Office and National DoL Office (Pretoria Central, Gauteng) on 16/10/2020.
- Global Day of Climate Action demonstrations anticipated in several provinces on 02/10/2020 – travel disruptions likely.
- Picket action anticipated at WCED Head Office (Cape Town Central, Western Cape) from September 2020 due to dissatisfaction with disciplinary action – travel disruptions foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with InXuba Yethemba Local Municipality expected to result in protest action in Cradock (Eastern Cape) from 30/09/2020 – travel and security risks anticipated.
- Route dispute expected to result in taxi unrest between Welverdiend and Carletonville (Gauteng) from September 2020 – risks to security and travel anticipated.
- Protest action anticipated in Sibongile (Dundee, KwaZulu-Natal) from September 2020 owing to several grievances with Endumeni Local Municipality – travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with non-payment on wages to result in protest action in/near Bekkersdal (Westonaria, Gauteng) from September 2020 – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Operational risks foreseen in several areas in George (Western Cape) from September 2020 owing to anticipated taxi related protest action voicing dissatisfaction with operating permits and additional implementation of Go George bus services.
- NUMSA industrial action anticipated at BOC operations in Gauteng from October 2020 owing to deadlocked wage negotiations – risks to business operations foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with booking system at the Vanderbijlpark Licencing Department in Vanderbijlpark CE 3 (Vanderbijlpark, Gauteng) to result in demonstrations from September 2020 – operational risks foreseen.
- Risks to business operations foreseen during anticipated COSATU demonstrations along several main roads in/near Durban (KwaZulu-Natal) on 07/10/2020 during one-day strike action.
- Dissatisfaction with GBV expected to result in travel disruptions and security risks during anticipated demonstrations in Mandini (KwaZulu-Natal) from September 2020.
- Dissatisfaction with retrenchments to result in strike action and/or demonstrations at Barloworld Head Office in Sandown (Sandton, Gauteng) from October 2020 – risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Demonstrations relating to dissatisfaction with alleged police brutality anticipated in Kwambonambi (KwaZulu-Natal) from 01/10/2020 – risks to travel and security expected.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated taxi related unrest in Seshego, Polokwane Central and Bendor (Polokwane, Limpopo) from October 2020 relating to route disputes.
- ILAWU protest march due to several grievances anticipated between Newtown, Ferreiras Dorp and Johannesburg Central (Gauteng) on 05/10/2020 – travel and security risks probable.
- Demonstrations expected at healthcare facilities nationwide from 02/10/2020 and at Eskom operations in Mpumalanga on 07/10/2020 during one-day COSATU strike action – risks to business operations foreseen.
