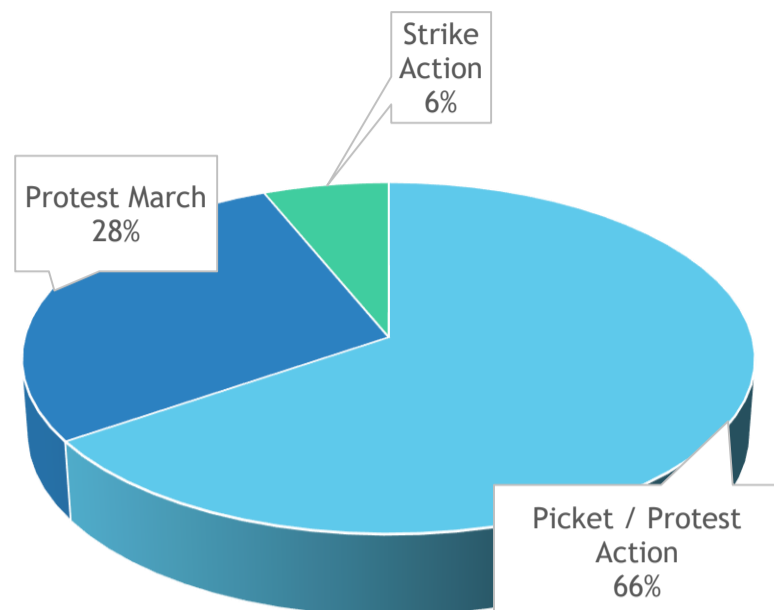

- **CGCRI Armed Robbery, 2020/10/24, 17:30. SPAR Algoa Park, Port Elizabeth, EC. 2 Suspects. Entered the store and demanded cash from the safe and tills. Suspects removed cash and fled the scene in white Nissan Micra, registration number unknown.**
- **CGCRI CIT - On Merchant Premises, 2020/10/26, 08:30. SPAR Southernwood, East London, EC. Unknown suspects. Approached the CIT guard and demanded the cash bag. Suspects removed cash and fled the scene in a white Ford Figo, registration number unknown. 2 CIT guards fatally shot and 1 customer shot and injured.**

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demonstrations anticipated at the Blue Downs Magistrate Court (Blue Downs, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 30/10/2020 during court proceedings of sexual assault accused - risks to travel and security foreseen
- EFF protest march to Mamusa Local Municipal Head Office (Schweizer-Reneke, North West) expected on 30/10/2020 owing to demand for adequate service delivery - travel and security risks foreseen
- Demand for employment expected to result in protest action in Laezonia (Centurion, Gauteng) from October 2020 - risks to travel and security foreseen
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at SABC operations nationwide from October 2020 owing to probable retrenchments - risks to business operations foreseen
- Housing related unrest anticipated in Fairleigh (Newcastle, KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 - risks to business operations foreseen
- Travel and security risks foreseen in Fish Hoek, Ocean View (Cape Town) and Dido Valley (Simon`s Town, Cape Town, Western Cape) from October 2020 owing to anticipated unrest due to dissatisfaction with housing allocations
- Demonstrations in support of Bushiri anticipated at the Pretoria Magistrate Court (Pretoria Central, Gauteng) on 30/10/2020 during court proceedings - travel and security risks foreseen
- Demand for water likely to result in protest action in King Cetshwayo District Municipality (KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Demonstrations expected at Polokwane Magistrate Court (Polokwane Central, Limpopo) during court proceedings on 02/11/2020 - travel and security risks anticipated
- EFF demonstrations anticipated at businesses nationwide from October 2020 owing to demand for UIF payments - travel and security risks foreseen
- Protest action anticipated in Reservoir Hills (Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 following fire outbreak - risks to travel and security foreseen
- Unrest anticipated in Bram Fischerville (Soweto, Gauteng) from October 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with prolonged electricity disruptions - operational risks expected
- Bulk electricity disruptions expected to result in unrest in Dr Beyers Naude Local Municipality (Eastern Cape) from October 2020 - businesses operations likely to be affected
- Strike action and/or demonstrations by e-hailing drivers expected nationwide from October 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Unrest expected in Dunoon (Cape Town, Western Cape) from October 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with illegal land occupants - operational risks anticipated
- Protest action anticipated in Emalahleni informal settlement (Dennisfield, Pietermaritzburg, KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with housing project delay - operational risks foreseen
- Wage negotiations underway between UNTU and PRASA - strike action and/or demonstrations expected from October 2020 pending outcome of wage negotiations
- NUMSA industrial action anticipated nationwide from October 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with non-implementation of wage agreement in Motor Industry - risks to business operations foreseen
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at D&B Industrial (Jacobs, Bluff, Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with management - operational risks foreseen
- Demonstrations anticipated at the Embassy of the USA in Arcadia (Pretoria, Gauteng) on 30/10/2020 - risks to travel foreseen
- KZNPAA protest march anticipated to the RAF Regional Office in Durban Central (KwaZulu-Natal) on 30/10/2020 owing to demand for unpaid funds for services rendered - risks to travel and security foreseen
- Demand for water likely to result in protest action in Weenen (KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Travel and security risks foreseen at Lenasia Taxi Rank and Jamia Masjid (Lenasia, Gauteng) from October 2020 due to anticipated unrest owing to dissatisfaction with temporary relocation of informal traders
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated protest action in Motherwell (Eastern Cape) from October 2020 owing to demand for electricity
- Unrest relating to the demand for service delivery anticipated in/near Eyadini informal settlement (Philippi, Cape Town, Western Cape) from October 2020 - risks to business operations foreseen
- Risks to travel and security foreseen during expected protest action in Harare (Khayelitsha, Cape Town, Western Cape) from October 2020
- Dissatisfaction with inadequate removal of waste anticipated to result in protest action in the vicinity of Industrial View (Mamelodi, Pretoria, Gauteng) from October 2020 - operational risks expected
- Social disorganisation relating to Guy Fawkes Day celebrations expected to result in risks to business operations in several areas in Cape Town (Western Cape) and in/near Port Elizabeth (Eastern Cape) on 05/11/2020
- CWU strike action underway at SAPO operations nationwide - demonstrations resulting in risks to business operations anticipated from October 2020
- Travel disruptions anticipated between Boksburg and Pretoria (Gauteng) on 01/11/2020 during anticipated demonstrations owing to dissatisfaction with farm murders
- Service delivery related protest action anticipated in Mizpah (near Greytown, KwaZulu-Natal) from October 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen on the R33
- Several grievances with Greater Taung Local Municipality to result in protest action in Taung (North West) from October 2020 - risks to travel and security foreseen
- EE demonstrations anticipated at National Treasury and DoE offices nationwide from October 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with education budget - risks to business operations foreseen
- Demand for adequate service delivery and employment opportunities likely to result in protest action in Hectorspruit (near Malelane, Mpumalanga) from October 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen
- Service delivery related protest action expected in Salt Lake (Bethelsdorp, Eastern Cape) from October 2020 - travel disruptions and security risks foreseen
- Demonstrations expected in Mankweng (Limpopo) from October 2020 owing to several grievances - risks to travel and security foreseen
- ATDF demonstrations anticipated at Transnet Port Terminals in Western Cape, Eastern Cape, KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng from 01/11/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with foreign national truck drivers
