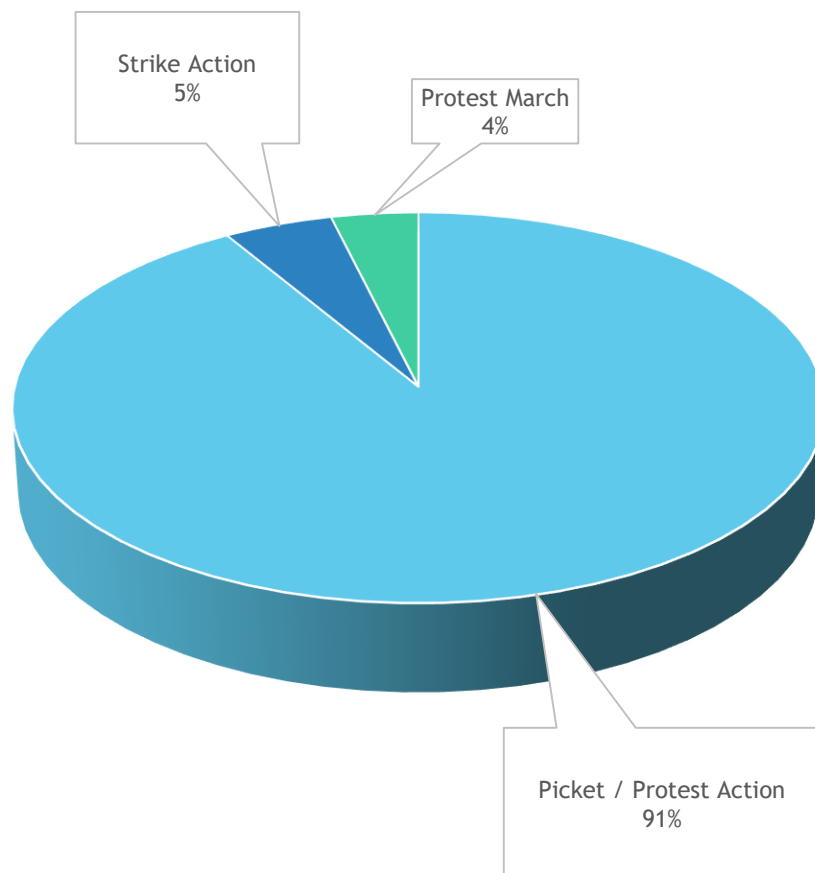

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- EFF demonstrations expected in Evaton (Gauteng) on 20/11/2020 owing to several grievances - risks to business operations foreseen
- Demonstrations anticipated at the Boksburg Magistrate Court (Boksburg South, Boksburg, Gauteng) on 27/11/2020 during court proceedings of Senzo Meyiwa murder accused - travel and security risks foreseen
- Demonstrations anticipated at the Port Elizabeth Magistrate Court (North End, Port Elizabeth, Eastern Cape) on 26/11/2020 during court proceedings of sexual assault accused - operational risks expected
- Risks to business operations foreseen at Brackenfell High School (Brackenfell, Cape Town, Western Cape) on 18/11/2020 and 20/11/2020 during anticipated demonstrations resulting from dissatisfaction with perceived racism
- Nationwide unrest relating to dissatisfaction with foreign nationals anticipated between 23/11/2020 and 25/11/2020 - risks to travel and security foreseen
- Strike action and/or demonstrations anticipated at SABC operations nationwide on 20/11/2020 to demand that issuing of retrenchment notices be halted - travel and security risks foreseen
- Picket action anticipated at Beacon Community Centre (Kliptown, Soweto, Gauteng) on 21/11/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with GBV - travel disruptions foreseen
- Taxi related demonstrations expected in several areas in Gauteng from 02/12/2020 owing to demand for COVID-19 relief funds - travel and security risks foreseen
- NUPSAW demonstrations anticipated at the National Treasury in Pretoria Central (Gauteng) between 25/11/2020 and 27/11/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with Public Sector wage freezes - risks to business operations probable
- Demand for housing likely to result in demonstrations at Western Cape High Court (Cape Town Central) on 24/11/2020 and in Woodstock (Cape Town, Western Cape) during November 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen

CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/11/18. 06:10. Pick n Pay Liquor Richmond Corner, Cape Town, Western Cape. 9 Suspects. Arrived at the store and held up security. Suspects forced open the front door with a crowbar and removed liquor and cigarettes. Suspects fled the scene in a silver/blue Toyota Corolla Quest, registration number CY373218, and a silver/grey Mazda 3, registration number CF266055. No shots fired or injuries reported.
