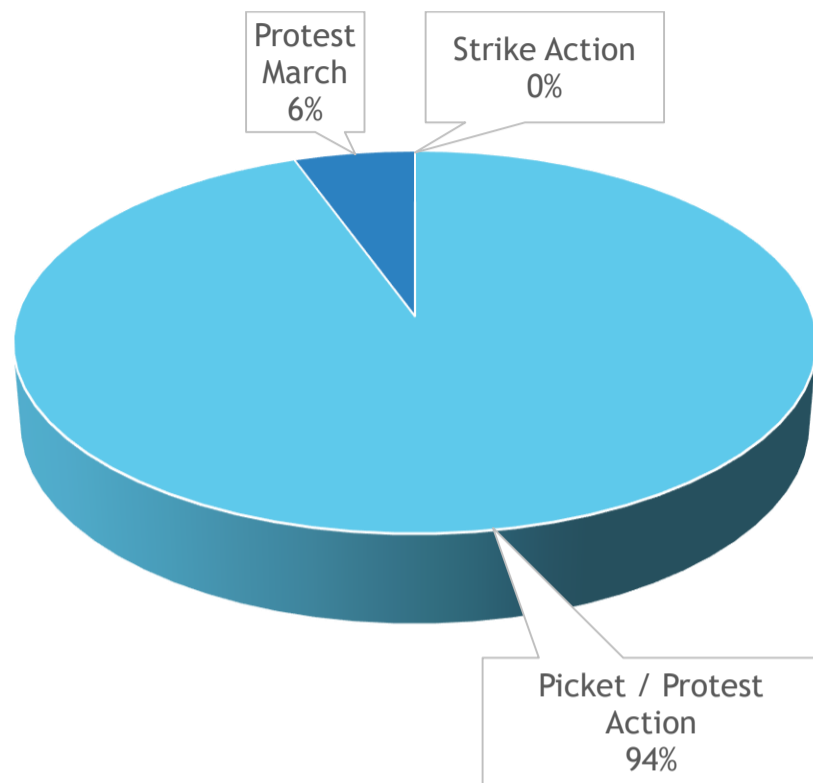

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Protest action anticipated in several areas in Msunduzi Local Municipality (KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 owing to frequent and prolonged electricity disruptions - risks to business operations foreseen
- Industrial action anticipated at KFC outlets in KwaZulu-Natal during December 2020 owing to labour related grievances - risks to travel and security foreseen
- Possible retrenchments at AMSA expected to result in industrial action at operations nationwide from December 2020 - risks to business operations foreseen
- PSA industrial action anticipated at SITA Head Office in Erasmuskloof (Pretoria, Gauteng) from December 2020 owing to deadlock in wage negotiations - risks to travel and security foreseen
- EFF protest march to Eskom Mpumalanga Regional Office in Evkompark 319-Js (Emalahleni, Mpumalanga) anticipated on 11/12/2020 - risks to travel and security foreseen
- SANCATDRA protest march to NBCRFLI Head Office (Braamfontein, Johannesburg, Gauteng) anticipated on 14/12/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with foreign nationals employed in Road Freight Industry - risks to travel and security anticipated
- Housing related protest action anticipated in Chief Albert Luthuli Park (Benoni, Gauteng) from December 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen
- SANCATDRA protest marches to NBCRFLI Head Office (Braamfontein, Johannesburg, Gauteng) anticipated on 14/12/2020 and 15/12/2020 owing to dissatisfaction with foreign nationals employed in Road Freight Industry - risks to business operations anticipated from 11/12/2020
- Demonstrations anticipated at DoD sites in Cape Town (Western Cape) from December 2020 owing to demand for repurposing into affordable housing - risks to travel and security foreseen
- LLHRF demonstrations expected at ABSA Group Limited Head Office in Johannesburg (Marshalltown, Johannesburg, Gauteng) on 11/12/2020 - risks to business operations foreseen
- Demonstrations and/or strike action anticipated at Limpopo DoH Head Office (Hospital Park, Polokwane, Limpopo) and at healthcare facilities in Limpopo from December 2020 owing to labour disputes - operational risks foreseen

Amavuso Crime Alerts

The below section lists the CGCRI Amavuso Crime Alerts which have been distributed over the course of the past week

- CGCRI Armed Night Robbery, 2020/12/04, 06:00. TOPS Rynfield, Benoni, GP. 9 Suspects. Gained access to the store by breaking through the front door with a crowbar. Suspects held up guards and removed expensive liquor. Suspects fled the scene in a white unknown panel van, registration number BY94KYGP and a silver Volkswagen Polo, registration number unknown. No shots fired or injuries reported.
