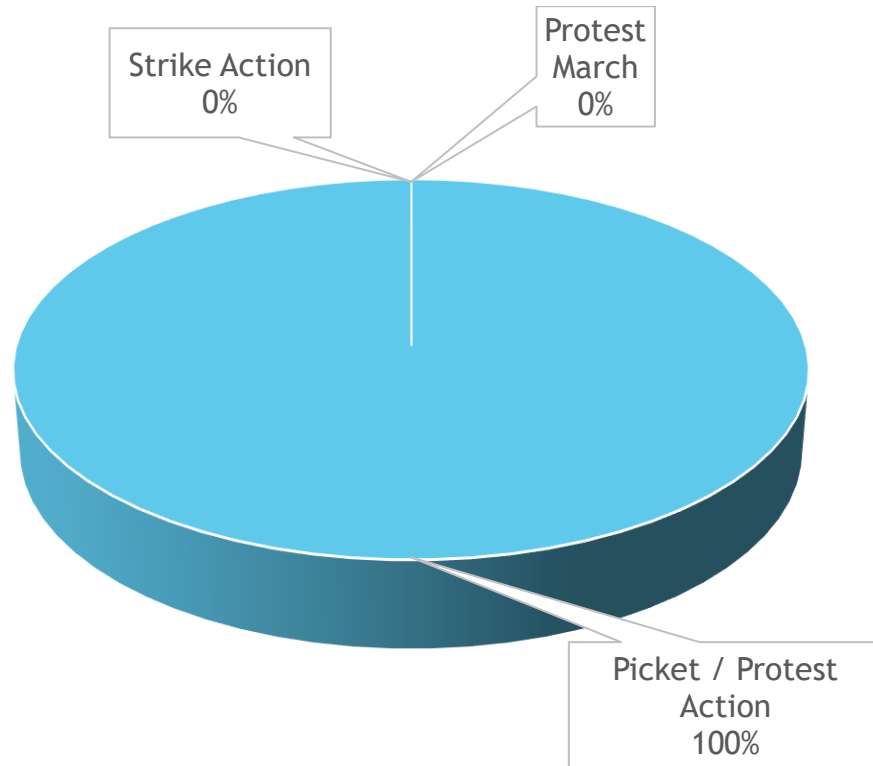

**TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events**

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Demonstrations anticipated in Bettysgoed (Mpumalanga) from December 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with supposed brutality by SANDF Members - foreseeable risks to travel and security.
- Service delivery related protest action expected in Melmoth, Ndundulu and Eshowe (KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated protest action in Madlanghala (near Richards Bay, KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 owing to demand for water.
- Protest action anticipated in Letsopa (Ottosdal, North West) from December 2020 owing to alleged inadequate service delivery - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated protest action in Danielskuil (Northern Cape) from December 2020 due to dissatisfaction with alleged non-payment of salaries.
- Protest action pertaining to dissatisfaction with gang violence expected in Ocean View (Cape Town, Western Cape) from December 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with prolonged electricity disruptions expected to result in protest action in Springfield (Durban, KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 - risks to business operations anticipated.
- Dissatisfaction with water disruptions expected to result in protest action in Matjhabeng, Nala (Free State) and Maquassi Hills (North West) Local Municipalities from December 2020 - operational risks foreseen.
- Increase in taxi related unrest foreseen in/near Mount Ayliff (Eastern Cape), from December 2020 owing to route disputes - risks to travel and security anticipated.
- Strike action and/or demonstrations expected at Cross Kwikspar (Musina, Limpopo) from December 2020 following positive COVID-19 cases - risks to business operations foreseen.
- Operational risks foreseen during anticipated service delivery protest action in Pumula (Hibberdene, KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 owing to dissatisfaction with water shortages.
- Grievances regarding electricity expected to result in protest action in Orange Farm (Gauteng) from December 2020 - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with open mine clusters expected to result in demonstrations in Vryheid (KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 - operational risks foreseen.
- Protest action anticipated in Nirvana Hills (Pinetown, KwaZulu-Natal) from December 2020 owing to alleged inadequate service delivery - risks to travel and security foreseen.
