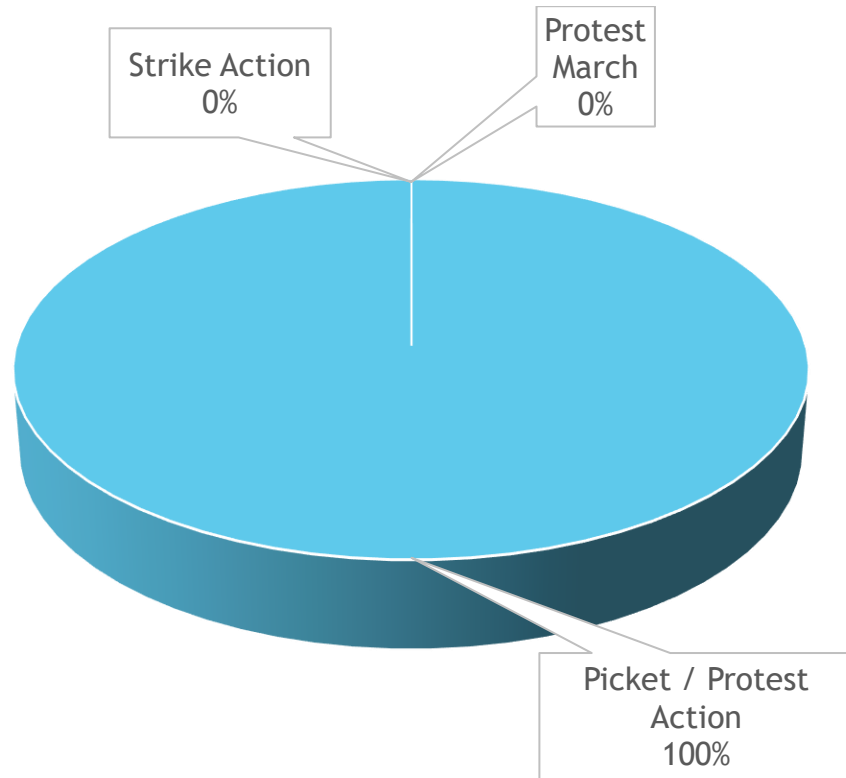

TopicWorx Alerts – Anticipated Events

The below section highlights unrest reported by TopicWorx to the CGCRI, which have been reported over the course of the week

- Travel disruptions probable at Beit Bridge Border Post (near Musina, Limpopo) during January 2021 owing to COVID-19 regulations in Zimbabwe.
- Increased incidents of gang-related unrest anticipated in the vicinity of Shallcross (Queensburgh, KwaZulu-Natal) from January 2021 following recent murder of alleged gang leader - risks to business operations foreseen.
- Demonstrations and/or strike action anticipated nationwide from January 2021 due to perceived increase in CIT robberies - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Delays in releasing of examination results expected to result in demonstrations at UL Turfloop Campus (Mankweng, Limpopo) during January 2021 - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations by municipal employees expected at Rustenburg Local Municipal Head Office (Rustenburg Central, North West) during January/February 2020 - risks to security and travel anticipated.
- Demonstrations and/or strike action anticipated in several areas in Bitou Local Municipality (Western Cape) during January/February 2021 owing to municipal labour dispute - operational risks foreseen.
- Dissatisfaction with crime expected to result in demonstrations in Canelands (Verulam, KwaZulu-Natal) during January/February 2021 - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demand for payment of salaries expected to result in demonstrations at the GDE Head Office (Marshalltown, Johannesburg, Gauteng) during January/February 2021 - risks to business operations foreseen.
- Illegal land occupation related protest action expected in the vicinity of Jakaranda informal settlement (near Freemanville, Klerksdorp, North West) during January/February 2021 - risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Industrial action anticipated at VMR Operations near Orkney (North West) and Viljoenskroon (Free State) during January/February 2021 owing to labour disputes - operational risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations expected in Tsholomnqa (Eastern Cape) during January/February 2021 owing to dissatisfaction with murder - risks to travel and security foreseen.
- Travel and security risks foreseen during anticipated protest action at Mogalakwena Mine (near Ga-Molekana, Limpopo) during January/February 2021.
- Dissatisfaction with inadequate service delivery expected to result in protest action in Boitekong (Rustenburg, North West) during January/February 2021 - travel and security risks foreseen.
- Demonstrations anticipated at the Union Buildings (Arcadia, Pretoria, Gauteng) during January/February 2021 owing to demand for rail infrastructure - expected risks to travel and security.
