COVID-19 HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

- Government has published the proposed health regulations relating to the surveillance and the control of COVID-19 and other notifiable medical conditions for public comments.
- The proposed regulations form part of the government's transition plans from the state of disaster to a permanent legal instrument to manage the outbreak of notifiable diseases.
- We invite all citizens and stakeholders to make written representations regarding the proposed health regulations to ensure their voices and views are considered when the government finalises the regulations.
